Technical Program

The M2GARSS 2020 technical program will include Oral, Poster and Tutorial Sessions and will deal with the following general themes:

- Natural Resources (water, minerals, agriculture, forests, renewable energies...)

Accepted papers will be published in the proceedings on IEEE Xplore only if presented at the Symposium by one of the list authors duly registered.
