Guidelines for Extended abstract Submission

1. Policy on Plagiarism

All extended abstracted submitted to **Student Poster Presentation -2021** will be checked for plagiarism (including self-plagiarism). If an abstract is found to fall in the category of plagiarism, the abstract will not be reviewed and automatically rejected. **The similarity index should be less than 15%.**

2. Templates

3. Extended abstract Format

- Extended abstract includes: Title of the extended abstract, Author details with affiliations, Abstract, Introduction, Methodology, Results, Conclusion, and references.
- Number of Pages: Abstract should not exceed three pages, including figures, tables and references (up to one additional pages will be permitted (for a total of 04 pages) in a paper
- Page Size: U.S. Letter format (8.5" x 11")
- File Format: PDF only
- Abstract: It is important that the abstract be a meaningful description of your extended abstract.
- Keywords: Choose from three to eight keywords.
