

JULY 1-8, 2014 LIGHTNING ROUND RESULTS

432 invitations were emailed to all members of the IEEE Columbia Section with addresses.

423 (98%) received, 9 (2%) bounced,

76 / 423 (17.6%) participated in the Lightning Round.
