1 Welcome / Introduction

The TC Chair, Prof. Abderrahim Benslimane, the Vice Chair for Publications, Dr. Rongxing Lu, and the Secretary, Dr. Bin Xiao, attended the meeting.

The meeting started at 12:30 pm in Shanghai, Level 2, Pudong Shangri-La Hotel, Shanghai, China.

Then, Prof. Abderrahim Benslimane firstly showed the meeting agenda and asked every attendee to sign the attendance form. He then briefly introduced the current TC officers listed below

He explained that the selection of the technical recognition award was still in the process, and the result will be announced in GC 2019.

5. Reports on Conferences

The TC Vice-Chair for Conference, Dr. Francesco Chiti can't come to attend the conference. He gave an overview on conference activities in CISTC online, via the WebEx online meeting system. Dr. Chiti introduced the CISTC organized Symposia in ICC'19 and Globecom'19, and presented CISTC affiliate conferences. 6. Reports on Publications

The TC Vice-Chair for Publications, Dr. Rongxing Lu, presented a report on the publication activities supported by the committee. He started by introducing the related special issues, upcoming special issues, and published books.

In particular, he mentioned CISTC members have contributed a lot and participated in many books (11 in total) and special issues (21 in total) in the past year. 7. Standards liaison

Dr. De-Nian Yang (Institute of Information Science, Academia Sinica, Taiwan), Secretary of Social Networks TC, attended Standard Board meeting on behalf of CISTC and presented during our meeting the news on Standard activities. He presented information related to the standards development board:

- Introduction
 - 35 public standards, 76 standardization projects, hundreds of entities involved
- Other related committees
 - Industry and Standard Activity Council
 - IEEE Tactile Internet Standards Working Group
 - IEEE Mobile Communication Networks Standards Committee
- Increase diversity of this standard committee
- Encourage more TC to come
- Encourage more people to this board (not just go to 3GPP)

He also mentioned how to participate the standards development board:

- How to participate?
 - Leader of standard projects -> working group chair -> standard committee member -> members at large -> chief standard officer, VP
- Need P&P to elect members a large, board members, officers, etc. and their eligibility and term limit
 - SA P&P, not COMSOC P&P
- VP finds budget and funding source (and revenue) to support standardization
- Two future important opportunities
 - Comms vehicles and smart manufacturing
 - Collaboration with IEEE VTS and industry electronics standard organization

8. CISTC SIGs

The TC Chair, Prof. Abderrahim Benslimane, mentioned that the current interest group in our CISTC website is not active anymore. We should initiate some new and up-to-date special interest groups. He proposed to start three SIGs: IoT cyber security, security in 5G, and security in blockchains. The following people volunteered to be the contact person for each group:
