TCI²N flagship event: GIIS 2013 & GIIS2014 & GIIS2015:

- The fifth edition GIIS 2013 was held in Trento, Italy (EIT ICT Labs, Trento Node). We received 83 submitted papers. The tentative program includes 3 Keynotes, 32 full papers (38,55%) and 10 short papers. The number of participants was more than 50 with participation.

- The sixth edition GIIS 2014 will be held in Montreal (University of Quebec at Montreal - UQAM, Canada). The conference dates are 15-19 September 2014. The tentative program includes 3 Keynotes, 23 full papers 1 invited paper (38%) + 13 short papers. The number of participants was more than 50 and student volunteers.

- The city of Tlemcen in Algeria was the first location agreed during ICC2014 (Sydney). For security reasons, the steering committee decided to change the location. The new potential location is Wuxi (China) given the connection with the IEEE Smart Cities Initiative. A first positive feedback from the local organizers but we are still waiting for final feedback from EITC (Economic and Information Technology Committee). The tentative Dates are November/December 2015.

Our standard liaison, Periklis Chatzimisios, was not able to attend the meeting but send some slides showing the Standardization activities in the next TCIIN meeting :

- Establishment of the IEEE Standards Research Group on IoT Communications and Networking Infrastructure. The plan of this Research Group will be the following: Duration of 8 to 12 months and the expected outputs are vision documents and publications (this action will be stimulated to organize Workshops and Special Sessions under IEEE Comsoc activities). The RG Chair is Prof. Stefano Giordano (s.giordano@iet.unipi.it).

- Establishment of the IEEE Standards Research Group on Software Defined and Virtualized Wireless Access. The first F2F meeting to be held at IEEE Globecom 2014 (10th December, 9 AM to 10 AM) with the following proposed agenda: (a) Present the current version of the white paper (15 mins) (b) Discuss any papers/presentations from RG members which are potential input to the whitepaper (30 mins) (c) Present the roadmap for completion of the white paper (15 mins).
