Paper submission deadline 1<sup>st</sup> of May, 2010.

Stefano Galli reports on the effort from the IEEE ComSoc to address the problem of Smart Grid in a broad, inclusive approach and on the ComSoc

Ad-Hoc Committee on Smart Grid Communications recently created by ComSoc President Byeong Gi Lee. Stefano Galli was appointed by Byeong Gi Lee to Chair the ad-hoc committee.

## **b) Paper Database issues**

Lutz Lampe reports. Call for volunteers to continue this project.

## **c) Report on standardization activities**

Stefano Galli reports on status of IEEE P1901, ITU-T G.hn, and the new ITU-T G.hnem. IEEE P1901 is going officially under sponsor ballot process. ITU-T G.hn has given final approval to PHY layer (G.9960) in October 2009, while the DLL (G.9961) layer has been consented in October 2009 and is now going through comment resolution. Also G.cx (G.9972, PLC coexistence) was consented in October 2009 and is now going through comment resolution. Final approval of G.hn and G.cx is expected for June 2010 in Geneva.

Jim LeClare (Chair of P1901.2) reports on the new IEEE P1901.2 working group for standardization of a low-frequency, narrowband PLC standard, for smart grid and electric mobility applications.

Gerd Bumiller comments on standardization efforts in Europe.

## **4. TC-PLC matters**

### **a) Report of N&EC, ratification of officers' elections**

Stefano Galli reports on the work of the N&EC.

Stefano Galli also reports that TC-PLC membership has grown from 50 to about 400 and has probably reached a critical size. He points out the fact that all new officers are academic, but this should not limit the TC interest and involvement in standardization and industry activities.

He also reports on an assignment given to the TC-PLC from Sergio Benedetto (VP Member Relations), Len Cimini (VP Publications) and Mark Karol (VP Technical Activities). The goal is to create a set of recommended and best readings, with some commentary; a set of open and key problems, including standardization. Initially this work would be posted on our TC website and maybe later put behind a password and available only to ComSoc members only. Also, a Community Group should be opened on ComSoc's website to facilitate ideas exchange between TC membership and

even foster panels with PLC experts. Although initial assignment was about PLC, Stefano Galli suggests to include topics related to PLC and Smart Grid as well. TC-PLC will be the first TC to look into this so we need to do a good job!
