7) Merging the TC-PLC with the Smart Grid Communications ETSC

1) Welcome and Opening

Andrea Tonello opens the meeting at 18:10

2) Approval of the previous meetings minutes

Minutes of the previous two meetings in Madrid and Washington are approved.

3) Conferences activity

a. Bamidele Adebisi presents the proposal of hosting ISPLC 2018 in Manchester, UK. The conference is considered to be from 08-11 April 2018. The conference venue will be the University of Manchester and not far away from the city center. Host demonstration and facilities are available at the venue. The conference website up and running, same as EDAS. Budget discussed with IEEE contact. Contract approval and payment procedure agreed with IEEE. CFP

publicized and reminder about paper submission deadline will go out.

- b. Alberto Sendin and Inigo Berganza report on ISPLC 2017 in Madrid. The conference consisted of a panel of experts, 4 keynotes, and 7 sessions. 69 submitted papers, 5 withdrawn, 33 accepted and 31 rejected (51.6%). 105 final registrations number, the 33 accepted papers brought only 25 presenters. Revenues for the Event are Patron fees + Attendance fees. Total revenues 54k€ + \$49k. No real contact with ComSoc since end of event. PCO had final closing with IEEE ComSoc, no news since then. The TC-PLC members thank Alberto for the organization.
- c. Andrea Tonello reports on WSPLC 2017. The workshop was hosted by the Czech technical university of Prague on 21 September with 50 Participants. The program should be published earlier. Overall, a successful event.
- d. Ralf Lehnert reports on SmartGridComm 2017 in Dresden. Four days from Mon, 23 to Thu, 26 Oct. 2017 at Taschenbergpalais Kempinski hotel. 4 workshops, very successful w.r.t. participants' opinions. 5 keynotes, 3 parallel tracks, 92 papers, 2 panels, 2 social events. 38 k€ income from patrons. Nice venue. Problems caused by the high number of participants of 195 and 3 session chairs did not show up. Communication with IEEE very formal: MoU took 1 year, contracting with vendors (venue, catering) inflexible.
- e. Gerd Bumiller reports on the status on Globecom 2017. 6 submitted papers, 1 accepted. No PLC session will be existed. Joint calls with smart grid communication shall be done.
- f. Andrea Tonello reports on the status of ICC 2018/19 and Globecom 2018/19.
- g. Andrea Tonello presents the proposal of hosting WSPLC2018 in University of Ljubljana, Slovenia, Faculty of Electrical Engineering. Local organizers are prof. dr. Matej Zajc and prof. dr. Nermin Suljanović. For ISPLC 2019, no Proposal submitted until now. Andrea Tonello is contacting Prague and Alfredo Sanz is contacting Dubai for proposal.
