## DETAILED MINUTES

Meeting called to order at 6:40 PM

### OPENING BUSINESS

1. M. Valenti opened the meeting by explaining that CTTC exists because of its members, and explained the definition of active membership. Officers and members present introduced themselves.
2. M. Valenti called attention to the minutes from the ICC 2015 CTTC meeting. The minutes were approved as distributed.
3. In his Chair's Remarks, M. Valenti explained what the CTTC is, and how to get involved. He emphasized the role of CTTC in the Communication Theory, Signal Processing for Communication, and Wireless Communication symposia. He solicited volunteers to co-chair future ICC/Globecom symposia. Those interested in volunteering should contact a CTTC officer. He also highlighted the role of CTTC in nominating members for awards. M. Valenti presented and congratulated the new CTTC members elected to be Fellows of the IEEE. He then summarized the location and dates of upcoming conferences through 2019. The Chair concluded his remarks by encouraging members to recommend books or articles for the "Best Readings" list, and reminding members of the purpose of the mailing list.

### SYMPOSIA AND WORKSHOP REPORTS

#### 4. Communication Theory Symposium Reports:

- Globecom 2015: O. Dobre reported on the statistics for the symposium. She also announced the Beat Paper Award winner.
- ICC 2016: M. Kountouris reported on paper submissions and TPC membership. A new topic was added to this conference on "Biological and Nanoscale Communication Theory".
- Globecom 2016: M. Brandt-Pearce introduced the conference to be held in Washington DC and encouraged members to submit papers.

#### 5. Workshop Reports:

- CTW 2016: M. Kountouris presented plans for the workshop after enticing the audience with beautiful photos of Nafplio, Greece. He summarized the technical program and encouraged members to attend.
- CTW 2017: J. Andrews presented plans for the workshop in Fiji, and how finalizing the dates had been difficult.

- He presented beautiful photos and discussed options for venues to hold the event.
- CTW 2018: D. Love proposed that the workshop be held in Puerto Rico. More gorgeous photos.

## MORE BUSINESS

### 6. CTTC Awards

- E. Perrins presented the Awards Committee and described the CTTC awards. He proposed a change to the Early Achievement Award:

To: "(ii) are within 10 years of their Ph.D."  
One additional change was suggested, to remove the word "young". Motion was made to accept the amended text, was seconded, and then passed.
- S. Benedetto was presented the Outstanding Service Award.
- J. Proakis were presented the Technical Achievement Award.

### 7. New Business

- S. Benedetto announced new IEEE cross-society initiatives. One COMSOC initiative is on 5G, and he invited CTTC to become proactive in this initiative.
- He invited CTTC to become more active in standards efforts.
- M. Valenti thanked S. Benedetto for his service as President of COMSOC.
