# FULL COMMITTEE MEETING IEEE PULP & PAPER INDUSTRY COMMITTEE INTERIM MEETING, ATLANTA, GA HOLIDAY INN NORTH OCTOBER 17, 1996 1:30 PM

#### **WELCOME & INTRODUCTIONS**

Committee Chair Dave Rollay called the meeting to order at 1:15 PM. The agenda is attached as **Appendix A**. After welcoming comments, all those present stood and introduced themselves.

Dave thanked Russ Thrift for arranging the meeting accommodations and the Hospitality room. He also thanked Alan Lowe for arranging the tour on Wednesday to the Georgia Department of Transportation Control Center.

#### **SECRETARY'S REPORT**

Committee Secretary Roger Jones reported that the minutes for the last meeting were distributed since the meeting and solicited corrections or adjustments. It was moved and seconded that the minutes be accepted as distributed. Extra copies of the minutes were made available.

The minutes for the next meeting will be distributed via e-Mail or on disk in a Microsoft Word format. Members are requested to provide their e-Mail addresses. This is intended to reduce the costs of distributing the minutes. An attendance sign up sheet was circulated and is attached as **Appendix B**.

#### **EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORT**

Roger reported that the Executive Committee met last night in this hotel. The meeting began at 6:00 PM and was presided over by Dave Rollay. Much of the material covered in that meeting will be covered here today. One item of business is that there will be a committee headed up by Russ Thrift that will be evaluating the location of future Interim Meetings. Russ, Alan Lowe, Rick Watkins, and Ron Meihofer will accept input. Alan Lowe will be reporting later in this meeting on the subject of continuing professional competencies for professional engineers.

#### **BIRMINGHAM CONFERENCE REPORT**

Local Conference Chair Preston Jackson recognized and thanked the people who served on the local committee as well as the people who attended the conference for making it a successful conference. He submitted his report which is attached as **Appendix C**. There were 333 attendees registered and 95 guests. Of these, 70 were first time attendees, there were nearly 100 mill attendees, and 136 registered for tutorials. Remaining conference records will be used to promote the next conference. With a few outstanding expenses yet to come in, receipts were in the neighborhood of \$122,000, and expenses just over \$80,000. Overall it was a very successful conference.

#### **STANDING COMMITTEE REPORTS**

a) Membership: Dave Rollay announced that, since Ron Simpson had accepted the position as treasurer, Alan Lowe has accepted the position of Membership Chair. Ron reported that the membership of the PPIC is currently 166. However, there are 25 of those members who are not presently listed in the IAS membership listing. It is a requirement of the Operating Guide of this committee that one must be a member of the IAS to be a member of this committee. Ron has sent letters out to 32 people, seven replied and cleared the issue for them. Alan has taken the charge to try once more to contact these and failing that, to terminate their membership on the PPIC.

There are 19 people in the application process. Also, 1 person has been dropped for missing too many meetings. Latest spreadsheet of the attendance at these meetings is attached as **Appendix D**, and the latest Roster of the committee is attached as **Appendix E** 

- b) **Mailing List:** Chair Bob Morse reported that the list is being updated from the data gathered at the last conference. We are also updating the Mill Managers mailing list.
- c) **Publicity:** Ron Meihofer reported that the Birmingham conference publicity report has not made it into the <u>IAS Magazine</u> yet because he has not received the photographs from the conference. He hopes to submit the report within the next two weeks. It has come to his attention that there is some information on our conference schedule on the IEEE web page (www.ieee.org).
- d) Awards: Russ Thrift reported that that the best paper award was a tie between Austin Bonnett's "Quality, Reliability, and Performance Levels of Energy Efficient Motors" and John Bentley & Pat Link's "Evaluation of Motor Power Cables for PWM AC Drives." The first and second place prize money was added and split between the two papers. The best mill paper was Doug Cruthirds & Steve Pittman's "Behavioral Based Safety Process, An Effective Compliment to OSHA Compliance." Russ recognized the efforts of the paper judges for the conference: Elton Parker, Alan Lowe, Sid Ticker, Kirk Armintor, and Jack Dwyer. The Meritorious Engineering and Meritorious Service Awards were presented to Dick Morrison and Ken Riddle respectively at the Birmingham conference. Russ solicited that anyone who had thoughts about nominations for these awards should contact him or Clayt Reid. We recommended 12 papers from the 1996 Conference to be published in the IEEE Industry Applications Magazine. Four have been selected for the Jan/Feb issue. We recommended 8 papers for publication in IEEE Transactions. Paper reviewers' names will be published with the papers as they are published.
- e) Conference Sites: Philip Fransen has agreed to be the Chairman of this committee. Philip reported that the conferences will be in Cincinnati 1997, Portland, ME 1998, Seattle 1999, and Atlanta 2000. Presently looking for a conference site for 2001 2004. The conference in 2004 will be our fiftieth annual conference. Presently Portland, OR, Victoria, BC, and Toronto, ON are interested in possibly hosting future conferences. Philip then reviewed the sites of previous conferences attached as **Appendix F**. He then solicited suggestions for the 2004 Conference. A discussion ensued regarding the lack of a person responsible for keeping the archives of the committee.
- f) **Fellows Nominations:** Chair Clayt Reid reported that we have three submittals into the IEEE. They are John Holmquist, John Bentley, and Mike Glenn. We will not know until December what the status of those are. He is planning to rework the nominations in the event they do not go through.

#### TREASURER'S REPORTS

Past Treasurer Roger Jones reported that the paper work is in for completing the Nashville audit. This is expected to be finalized and included in the minutes of this meeting. The summary is attached as **Appendix G**.

Past Treasurer Roger Jones reported that the Vancouver audit is reported by the IEEE to be complete. However, he has been unable to obtain a copy of the final audit nor has he seen a copy of the letter from the IEEE certifying the audit.

#### LIAISON REPORTS

- a) **TAPPI:** Burt Judson reported that TAPPI's PCE&I will meet in Birmingham at the Sheraton Hotel and an equipment show will accompany the conference. The dates are 3/10 13.
- b) **CPPA:** Clayt Reid reported that the meeting and equipment show will be in Montreal at the end of January.
- c) IAS: Clayt Reid reported that, at the IAS Conference, Austin Bonnett received the IAS Achievement award. Rich Carle won the first IAS Magazine award for an article of his. IAS will have a membership booth at the next PPIC conference. Note that IAS is 12,000 of approximately 200,000 total IEEE members.

#### **OPERATING SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS**

- a) **EMMC:** Russ Thrift reported that there were 16 present in the meeting with a lot of input from mill people. Four papers and a panel are proposed for the conference and Rhonda Banks and Jack Dwyer will be paper graders. **Appendix H.**
- b) **PDS:** Alex Wu reported that attendance was 18 members and 3 guests. They are proposing 19 papers total with 9 of these solid papers and 1 panel. Paper reviewer is Tung Chao. **Appendix I.**

- c) **TSSC:** Robert Cotton proposed 3 papers and one 15- minute code update. Steve Pittman will be paper reviewer. **Appendix J.**
- d) **DCS:** Burt Judson reported for Mark Weaver. Twenty four attended and proposed 13 papers and one tutorial. Paper grader will be Duncan Rhodes. The tutorial will be on the topic on the Motor Master Program and will require a PowerPoint projection capability. Participants will be asked to bring their laptops for hands on software instruction. **Appendix K.**
- e) **CBS:** Reno Tonsi reported that 9 members and 2 guests were present. Kirk Armintor will be the paper reviewer. Four papers, one panel, and one tutorial are proposed. Blake Lloyd will work on a Home Page for the PPIC and submit it to the Executive Committee for their approval. **Appendix L.**
- f) **Power Quality (Ad-Hoc):** Ed Reid reported that 6 members and 2 guests attended. Approximately 5 of the proposed papers are power quality issues. **Appendix M.**
- g) Motor Specifications/Recommended Practices (Ad-Hoc): Austin Bonnett reported that the group looking at IEEE 841 motor standards. Approximately 50 attended in June and they will meet after the meeting. Appendix N.

#### 1997 CINCINNATI CONFERENCE REPORT

Bruce Clayton reported that the tours planned for Tuesday will be 1) Wright Patterson AFB and their Museum of Aviation, and 2) the King's Island amusement park - a tour of the inner workings of the park continuing on to the Aviation Museum. The social event for Thursday will be at Coney Island and will be a State Fair Motif. The local committee is working to encourage first time attendees and local (200 mile radius) attendees.

#### 1997 CINCINNATI TECHNICAL PROGRAM

Larry Thomas visited each subcommittee this morning and gave each chair a form to better list the papers proposed by the respective subcommittees. The chairs got together at lunch to review the proposed papers and the new paper readiness/rating report. This report was reviewed for the full committee. Alan Lowe reported on the subject of continuing professional competency units for Registered Professional Engineers to maintain their licenses. This report is attached as **Appendix O**. PDHs can be acquired by presenting or attending qualified seminars which means that one who attends the technical sessions can pick up hours. Authoring papers earns 10 hours and active participation on the PPIC will also qualify for hours. The individual will be responsible for ensuring that their state will accept the PDHs resulting from the IEEE participation. A voucher will be made available at the sessions.

Burt Judson reported on the conference critique and has put together a summary of suggested titles and topics and distributed these to the subcommittee chairs for consideration in their meetings. There are many good ideas and encouragements for the subcommittees.

Burt also reported on the results of the Executive Committee teleconference. This is attached as **Appendix P.** The Executive Committee has initiated action on most of these topics.

John Bentley reported on the passing of a former member and Meritorious Service Award recipient: Marty Fisher. Marty usually insisted that the people who worked for him join at least one professional organization and present at least one technical paper per year -- an excellent example for those of us who are in management.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Clayt Reid brought up the subject of encouraging young engineers to attend our conferences and identify ways for them to become more active on our committee. He will continue to pursue this and report at the next conference.

The meeting was adjourned.

#### AD HOC IEEE 841 MOTOR SPEC GROUP

Meeting Date: October 17, 1996

**Location:** Atlanta, GA

**Purpose:** Consideration of Application of IEEE 841 Motor Standard to the Pulp & Paper Industry

**Attendees:** (unknown - list was lost)

- 1. The meeting was co-chaired by Austin Bonnett/US Electrical Motors and John Holmquist/Weyerhaeuser.
- 2. Mr. Bonnett reviewed the courses of action open to the committee.
  - Adopt IEEE 841 as is.
  - Develop a separate version of IEEE 841 suitable for the forest products industry.
  - Abandon the committee effort.
  - Provide constructive input, along with the PCIC, for the next revision of IEEE 841. To this end, Mr. Bonnett distributed a list of possible changes to IEEE 841-1994, along with comments received from Pulp & Paper Committee Members to date. Member of the Ad Hoc committee were asked to review the suggested changes and send comments to Mr. Bonnett.
- 3. Since Mr. Bonnett needed to leave early, Mr. Holmquist led a discussion of Weyerhaeuser's IEEE 841 Specifications for Severe Duty TEFC NEMA Frame T Motors, Rev. 5. The resulting comments are listed by WPC spec. section numbers.

### 5. <u>ELECTRICAL DESIGN</u>

Use of insulated ODE bearings and shaft grounding is not addressed in this spec.

- 5.3 Many mills have trouble maintaining voltage unbalance of 1%, so the WPC spec. was changed to 1.5%. However, since voltage unbalance has a marked impact on motor vibration, this tolerance was returned to 1%, consistent with IEEE 841 5.3.b.
- 5.9 The stator winding insulation requirement of 1600 volts is only good for inverter outputs with rise times ≥ 0.1 microsecond, as listed NEMA MG1-1993, Section 31.40.4.2. Since some smaller hp drives with high modulation frequencies may have rise times much shorter than this, there is concern that the voltage rating should be increased to 2000 volts or more. Perhaps IEEE 841 Section 5.3.c should be revised to cover these cases.

### 6. <u>MECHANICAL DESIGN</u>

- 6.1 It was clarified that specifying "Ball bearings shall have AFBMA C3 clearances" refers to the internal fit between the bearing race and balls. Reliance Electric reps. were asked to recommend a tolerance for fit between the outer race to frame and from inner race to shaft.
- 6.2 Lithium based grease is not required. Retain the specification of polyurea thickened grease.
- 6.5 There was discussion about how to specify the L-10 life of belted applications that have roller bearings. This may need to be treated as an exception to account for bearing skidding.
- The requirement to be able to modify all horizontal motors to accommodate oil mist lubrication was questioned. Should this be listed as an option? Some have recommended that this section be left out.

- 6.12 The drilled and tapped grounding hole should have a corrosion resistant bolt installed. It should be noted that this requirement is in addition to the practice of running a grounding conductor with the phase conductors within the power conduit.
- 6.13 Although some would like to see the flatness tolerance tightened from 0.005" to 0.003", this may drive up the cost while giving only marginal improvement in motor performance.
- 6.15 Although half glued gaskets are very important for ensuring good sealing of the conduit box, special care needs to be taken to ensure that the frame and motor grounding conductor are connected to the same ground point. This is especially important for inverter applications.
- 6.19 Nameplate data
  - a) Delete "and C3 clearance".
  - b) Manufacture date should be given in "mo/yr" format, not some manufacturers code.
  - g) In place of warranty life, the winding resistance at 25 deg. C should be added. This is needed for some of the newer computerized motor status programs. This is also why WPC asks for items k & l, No. of bars & no. of slots.
- 6.21 It would be nice if all motors could be specified with VPI treatment for windings, especially for inverter duty. But most manufacturers aren't set up for this. When motors above 50 hp are rewound, VPI is required.

### REPORT TO EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

# CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING REGISTRATION WHICH MAY BE SATISFIED BY ATTENDANCE AT IEEE PULP & PAPER CONFERENCES

Many states now have continuing professional competency (CPC) requirements for relicensing of professional engineers. Others plan to implement this policy in the near future. Attachment 1 to this report is a copy of the survey results from the National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying (NCEES). The summary table shows which states now have CPC requirements and which plan to implement them in the next one to five years.

Attachment 2 is a copy of "Continuing Professional Competency Guidelines" published by the NCEES. The guidelines are recommended to the various jurisdictions in order to provide as much consistency as practical. However, each state is free to determine its own set of requirements.

The NCEES Model Rules require 15 professional development hours (PDH) per year for relicensing. After reviewing the Model Rules and discussing them with members of the NCEES, I believe that there are several ways in which participation in the IEEE Pulp & Paper Committee can qualify for PDH credit.

Presenting or attending qualifying seminars, in-house courses, workshops, or professional or technical presentations made at meetings, conventions, or conferences. (1 hour of presentation = 1 PDH)

Teaching or instructing above. (Multiple by 2)

Authoring published papers, articles or books. (10 PDH per paper)

Active participation in professional or technical societies. (2 PDH per year per society) Active participation requires licensee to serve as an officer and / or actively participate in a committee of the organization.

Because our technical sessions generally run three to four hours each, attendance at our annual conference would provide enough PDH's for an entire year's requirement.

The licensee is responsible for maintaining records to support PDH credits. Records required include, but are not limited to: (1) a log showing the type of activity claimed, sponsoring organization, location, duration, instructor's or speaker's name, and PDH credits earned; (2) attendance verification records in the form of completion certificates, or other documents supporting evidence of attendance.

### CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCIES APPENDIX O

In my opinion item (1) above could be satisfied by modifying the conference program to include the number of PDH's for each tutorial and each technical session. For example:

### SESSION 1 (3.5 PDH\*)

The \* would refer to a statement similar to the following printed on the program: "It is the opinion of the executive committee of the IEEE Pulp and Paper Committee that attendance at these tutorials and technical sessions qualifies as Professional Development Hours (PDH) for most state licensing boards. However, final approval is within the authority of the individual boards."

Satisfying item (2) may involve more of an effort on the part of the committee. The attendee will have a receipt to show that he paid for a tutorial or for the conference. This of course does not prove that he attended. Simple certificates could be given out for the tutorials. Some method to verify attendance at the technical sessions may be required. Perhaps a small attendance voucher made available for each session. Whatever method we select, the committee should have a plan in place before the June conference.

I believe that PDH credit for conference attendance can be an asset for promoting our conferences. I also believe that the committee can provide a valuable service to our members and guest by making the documentation process as convenient as possible.

I will be happy to work with the committee to help formulate a procedure for handling PDH's. Because every state can have different requirements and these requirements can change from time to time, I believe that the committee should try to work within the Model Rules of the NCEES and that each licensee should keep up with the requirements for the states in which he is registered.
