IEEE/IAS PULP & PAPER INDUSTRY COMMITTEE INTERIM MEETING MINUTES OF THE FULL COMMITTEE WAVERLY HOTEL ATLANTA, GEORGIA OCTOBER 13, 1999

WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Larry Thomas called the meeting to order at 12:30 PM and welcomed everyone to Atlanta, GA and to the Full Committee meeting. Larry announced that a roster is being circulated and asked attendees to check data including member status such as senior, lifetime, fellow, member etc. Larry also announced that a sign in sheet is being distributed. Larry then asked everyone to stand and introduce themselves.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

Ron Simpson circulated sign-in sheets for each member in attendance to sign in order to record their attendance. Ron reported that the minutes for the last meeting were distributed, and solicited comments. The minutes were approved as submitted. Ron reported that:

The full committee has 134 active members.

The minutes were sent out using 109 email addresses with 6 returned undeliverable.

25 members with no email were sent minutes via postal service.

Of the minutes sent by postal service, there were 6 undeliverable addresses.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORT

Ron Simpson reported that the Executive Committee met the previous evening in this hotel and that there were 17 in attendance.

SEATTLE CONFERENCE REPORT

Tom Shearer has resigned from the PPIC. He now has job with Rockwell outside the Pulp and Paper Industry. Phil Fransen reported on the Seattle conference in his behalf. The conference reported a \$3995 surplus. Conference records have been received by IEEE but it is unknown if they have paid the local committee (about \$2000). TAPPI has copyright on 2 or 3 papers presented at the Seattle conference. IEEE may not pay for the conference books if the copyright has been violated. Phil will send an email report next week on the status of the conference close out.

Mark Weaver received a bill for unfilled rooms which the local committee was told were not available. This is in negotiation with the hotel at this time. The conference close out is immediately following the conference now that the interim meeting expenses come from the next conference. IEEE is negotiating with the hotel on the disputed room charges for \$12K.

TREASURER'S REPORT/CONFERENCE AUDITS

Phil Fransen has no further reports. Seattle is the only audit outstanding at this time.

STANDING SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

MEMBERSHIP

Alan Lowe reported that membership is 143 members. There are 27 applications pending. Since the last Interim Meeting, there have been 0 resignations and 1 new member.

MAILING LIST

Larry Thomas reported for Bob Morse that the mailing list was updated with the 1999 corrections from the conference mailing list books, the 1999 conference registration disk, and the added names sent to the mailing list coordinator during the year. The revised mailing list will be sent to the Atlanta committee for the 2000 conference. A suggestion was made to send a post card to the mailing list with the IEEE PPIC web site address.

PUBLICITY

Ron Meihofer reports that the publicity information has not been sent to the IAS magazine yet. He will send the information next week.

None of the awards pictures came out. Ron asks for pictures taken by attendees that might be suitable for publicity.

Larry sent the pictures out which were taken by Blake. None of the paper presentation awards pictures came out. They are presumed not suitable for publication due to the poor quality as Blake was sitting far back from the presentation.

AWARDS

Roger reports the need for more mill papers. A comparison of last year and this year shows that we must have all papers classified as "A" or "B" come through this year. We have a need for more papers with real life experiences from mill people. Another issue that needs to be addressed is commercialism. The technical papers should not sell a product or service. New Product Presentations do this. Reviewers and sponsors should target commercialism in their review of papers. The authors should ask the question "if my competitor reads this would he feel uncomfortable?" Templates are available to write papers. Standardized fonts and formats are included in the templates. Authors should use the templates to assure conformance with the standard. Attendees and committee members should bring new people to the conference to increase attendance. Senior engineers in the company should bring apprentices.

2001 PORTLAND OREGAN REPORT

Phil Fransen reports for George Matto. The local committee is working on a hotel. The contract is in place. There will be a 10-22-99 meeting at the Marriott to review the facilities. The committee is considering ideas for the social and guest programs. The conference is now less than 2 years out and work is beginning.

FUTURE CONFERENCE SITES

Phil Fransen reports that the Empress Hotel being considered for the 2004 conference in Victoria is over \$200/night. He feels that \$200 is critical number and he will look into another hotel in Victoria or Vancouver.

Toronto

John Kay reports that rates in Toronto are attractive. The conference is tentatively scheduled for week of June 16 in 2002. Sheraton Center has received the most awards of any Canadian hotel. It is a world class facility located in downtown Toronto. The city boasts an underground walkway that is a total of 10 miles in length.

Charleston

Rhonda Banks reports that one hotel in town has enough room for the conference but is asking \$219/night. Rooms would be less expensive in July as compared to June. The hotel that is under consideration is Charleston Place. Rhonda is still negotiating with this hotel.

OLD BUSINESS

Larry Thomas reports on the survey of the PPIC on changing the location of the interim meeting. The committee is reviewing other locations outside Atlanta due to the hotel shortages encountered in recent years and the increased travel expenses into Atlanta.

Larry leads the discussion on the location of the interim meeting for the year 2000. Larry reports that the survey shows that Orlando is acceptable to the membership for the interim meeting. Larry will look into setting up the meeting. Membership flying in from the West Coast encounters high airfare to Atlanta. Airfare to Orlando is much cheaper. This fare runs about 1/3 of the Atlanta airfare. The target price for hotels is less than \$135/night. The interim is tentatively scheduled for 2 weeks after the Rome conference and is scheduled for Monday, Oct 23, 2000. Monday meetings result in better hotel rates than Tuesday or Wednesday. The executive meeting is scheduled for Sunday, Oct. 22. The final dates and announcement of the chosen hotel will accompany the mailing of the minutes. See Appendix K for his open letter to the committee on this subject.

Larry reminds the subcommittee chairs of the IAS/IEEE 2000 Rome meeting week of Oct. 9, 2000. He needs paper authors, sponsor and reviewers now. 5 papers are known at the present time. Larry also reminds the committee of the need to submit nominees for the PPIC awards. Larry needs a list of paper graders and alternates from each subcommittee.

Abstracts for papers for the IAS conference are due by Nov. 30, 1999. The rules for the Rome conference are the same as for the PPIC. The review process is also the same. 6 papers have been identified for the Rome conference. Larry needs 6 abstracts and digest by Nov. 30, 1999. Authors will be notified of acceptance or rejection of papers by Jan 31, 2000. Acceptance or rejection is based on subcommittee chair recommendations. Larry does not review the papers. Mar 31 is the deadline for camera ready copy. No papers will be accepted after this. Forms A and B must be filled out. These forms are similar to our authors data and copyright forms. Mark Weaver will be the session chair in Rome. Mark says that the hotel rooms should be reserved by March. IAS has not adopted a 100% power point presentation format. Papers must, however, be in the IAS style.

Larry passed out list of suggested topics for future papers. He needs a tutorial list for the June conference to include title, presenter and contact. One tutorial is presently known. This is the tutorial taught by Shoaib Khan.

WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Del Seaver called the meeting to order at 7:30 am and welcomed everyone to Atlanta. All present introduced themselves. There were 17 attendees with 13 excused absences at the beginning of the meeting. All present were asked to sign the attendance sheet that was passed around.

Attendees were also asked to check the mailing list that was passed around.

Alan Lowe noted that it is a good idea to upgrade your IEEE membership to Senior Member. The only requirement is the recommendation of three other Senior members.

TOPICS DISCUSSED

Rome IAS Conference

The Rome Conference is scheduled for October 8-12, 2000, in Rome, Italy. In order for a paper to be included in the Rome conference, the following schedule must be met:

- Abstract submitted to committee, 1-31-2000
- Approval
- 3-31-2000 Camera ready (Done).

The June Atlanta conference schedule is as follows:

- Rough draft by 11/8/99,
- final draft to reviewers by 12/20/99,
- Reviewed papers to sponsors by 1/24/2000 with release forms, etc.,
- final manuscript complete by 3/6/2000.

Awards-Seattle

Austin Bonnett's paper "The Impact that Voltage and Frequency Variations have on AC Induction Motor Performance..." won second best paper. Those selected for publication include Austin's paper along with Sander OKane's paper on intelligent motors and Mark Hodowanec's paper on proper application of motors on adjustable frequency control.

Awards-Atlanta

Members were asked to give some thought to nominations for the Engineering and Service Awards for the Atlanta conference. A list was distributed for members to review.

Atlanta - Papers

The number of papers presented in Seattle was almost entirely written by vendors. It was asked that the members encourage mill personnel to participate in the meetings more. Since there were only two mill papers presented, it was noted that winning the top mill paper prize would be a distinct possibility.

Duncan Rhodes had previously volunteered for the paper reviewer's job in Atlanta. Pat McNulty will be the alternate.

The subject of excess commercialism in presentations was discussed. It was noted that it is the responsibility of the reviewers and ultimately the sponsor to ensure that commercialism is not found in the papers. It is the responsibility of the session moderator to ensure that the presentation does not have commercial content. This would include the question and answer session afterward. A question was raised, "Should all questions be channeled through the session moderator for filtering?" No conclusion was reached.

The format for all of the presentations will continue to be in Power Point. If an author is to use slides, then he will be personally responsible for providing the projector etc. This method is not recommended. Likewise, for best results, it is recommended that all of the presentations be processed through one computer, usually provided by Blake Lloyd.

The list of papers was reviewed and a total of 24 papers were discussed. From that, five "A" papers and six "B" papers were identified. These were tentatively planned for Atlanta. An additional four papers were identified as "C", two "D", and four "E". Others were deleted because they had been presented already, or it was determined that they would not ever come together for one reason or another.

Del Seaver adjourned the meeting at 11:00 am.
