IEEE/IAS PULP & PAPER INDUSTRY COMMITTEE ANNUAL CONFERENCE MEETING MINUTES OF THE FULL COMMITTEE WESTIN AIRPORT HOTEL ATLANTA, GEORGIA

OCTOBER 20, 2003

WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Ron Simpson called the meeting to order at 1:01 PM. He welcomed everyone to Atlanta and the Full committee meeting. He then asked everyone in turn to introduce him or herself. Allan Lowe circulated a meeting sign in sheet and asked all attendees to indicate their presence. He also circulated the committee roster for people to make corrections.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

Blake Lloyd reported that the full committee minutes were sent out on 9/23/2003 7:02 AM. This was a bit later than they should have been and at the Executive meeting it was resolved that the subcommittee chairpersons would have their minutes to the Secretary within 2 weeks of the meeting and that the Secretary would have the minutes assembled and issued within 2 weeks of that. A permanent web site will be used to distribute the minutes from now on.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORT

Blake Lloyd reported that 16 members were in attendance at the Executive Committee meeting. The meeting started at 6PM Sunday evening and adjourned at about 8:30PM. Ron Simpson as chairman had significantly changed the format of the executive meeting to make the discussion more issues and steering related. There was a lot of discussion with regards to the initiatives being applied to the format for the Victoria conference.

2003 CHARLESTON CONFERENCE REPORT

Rhonda Banks reported the following conference attendance for the Charleston conference: 143 attendees, 49 guests, 109 attended the social, with a room pickup of 79% (the target was 90%). Initially the hotel penalty was to be \$6K which was negotiated down to \$3K which will leave the conference with a small surplus. An audit of the conference will be done when the final checks have cleared.

TREASURER REPORT/CONFERENCE AUDITS

Dave Durocher reported that all past conferences (except for Charleston) have been audited and are closed.

STANDING SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

MEMBERSHIP

Our current committee membership is 111. Since the annual meeting in June we have had the following changes in membership, five (5) new members, four (4) members have retired, one (1) member pasted away prior to the annual meeting and twelve (12) members have been dropped for lack of participation: A full report is given in the Appendix.

MAILING LIST

John Kay reported that the list was updated and a revised list has been sent to the Victoria Conference for their use.

PUBLICITY

Ron Meihofer was absent but reported that the publicity release on the 2003 Conference held in Charleston, SC on June 16-20 at the Francis Marion Hotel will be published in the IEEE Industry Applications Magazine's January/February

2004 issue. Announcements for the 2004 Conference to be held in Victoria, British Columbia on June 27-July 1, 2004 will be sent to the various trade magazines in January.

PAPER AWARDS AND PUBLICATIONS

Laurie Cihlar reported that we continue to be very successful with papers submitted to transactions and the IAS Magazine. Details are given in the Appendix.

Sponsors of papers which have been previously presented in another forum are cautioned to ensure that this information accompanies the paper and that the paper awards and publication person is aware of this. Such papers should be acknowledged as such presented elsewhere in our proceedings, and should not be submitted twice to IAS. Such papers are eligible for awards at our conference.

The definition of a "Mill Paper" for awards was clarified and is a paper with ONLY mill authors on it. Should no pure mill papers be available at a particular conference, a paper including a mill author and others will be considered for the Best Mill Paper award.

PPIC AWARDS

Russ Thrift urged everyone to be thinking about candidates deserving of the Engineering and Service Award. He would like subcommittee chairs to use the form in the Operating Guide, along with any other pertinent information available from a candidates resume and peers.

FELLOWS NOMINATIONS

Clayton Reid reported that he is working on an application for Ron Simpson for IEEE Fellow and hopes to have it completed for March.

Liaison Reports

XFOR

John Kay reported on XFOR, which is the worlds largest exhibition in pulp and paper plus a 3 day technical conference that was held in Montreal and was a good success. The next XFOR will be during the week of January 26 in Montreal next year.

IEEE/IAS

Clayton Reid reported on the IAS conference held at Salt Lake city which was again this year at about 650 attendees. Clayton is also nominating John Holmquist for a technical achievement award for the IAS.

TAPPI

Burt Judson reported on TAPPI. Their PCE&I division most closely parallels our group and their Electrical engineering committee would like to hold a joint conference in Jacksonville in 05. Burt and Rory will pursue an investigation of this option. The next TAPPI technical conference is in May 3-5 in Atlanta.

IEEE - STANDARDS COORDINATING

Jim Daily continues to monitor IEEE standard changes that might effect our industry.

2004 VICTORIA CONFERENCE REPORT

Mark Weaver reported on progress for the Victoria Conference. Declining attendance has been an issue – and the local committee is trying a large number of initiatives aimed at curbing the current trend. They have is important– the have produced a snazzy brochure hand out brochure and encourage members who call on mills to hand these out. Packets of 50 were distributed to those at the meeting that thought they could distribute them. A PDF version is also available at the conference web site www.pulppaper.org. The local committee would like to remind members to get the word out – the conference is a week later than normal (ie not fathers day!) – and conference technical presentations start Monday. Monday and Tuesday are open for Vendor events. This is the 50th anniversary of the conference and hopefully a very successful one.

2004 VICTORIA TECHNICAL PROGRAM

Rory Johnson reported on the upcoming technical program. The authors guide will undergo some revisions to clear up confusion on formatting in Word, instructions on papers presented elsewhere, and the visual presentation rules for authors to get their presentations to Duncan Rhodes before or during the conference. This revised guide will be sent out by the end of October.

Rory has added some new forms and would like to use an Excel spreadsheet for subcommittee chairpersons and sponsors to use for paper tracking and reviews.

FUTURE CONFERENCES

2005 - JACKSONVILLE, FL

Rich Butler reported that in 2005 the PPIC conference is on for Jacksonville, FL June 20 to the 24. The hotel is the Adams Mark Hotel on the waterfront which is one of the anchor hotels for the super bowl this year. He has contracted for 650 room nights at the hotel. The local committee is set up, and the local IEEE chapter involved. There may also be an opportunity to cooperate with TAPPI on a joint meeting.

2006 - MILWAUKEE, WI

Duncan Rhodes is in the process of forming a committee for this conference. He solicited input on the local – either Milwaukee proper or Appleton which would be more expensive to get to – but cheaper on a the room rate.

2007 - Texas

Various sites in Texas are under consideration including Houston, Dallas, and San Antonio.

OLD BUSINESS

Dave Rollay reported recommendations on next years interim meeting. Site alternatives explored included going back to Atlanta, coexist with TAPPI, or going to Jacksonville where the 2005 conference will be held. Dave will do a survey before the Victoria conference. Obviously those in the west have a concern about another east coast interim meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

.Dave R reported on the Survey taken in Charleston – there were 35 responses and lots of suggestions all of which were passed on to the executive and to the Victoria conference chairpersons. Overall the Charleston conference received the highest rating for the 6 years that these statistics have been collected..

ANTITRUST

IEEE's policy prohibits any discussion which constitutes or implies an agreement or tacit understanding concerning:

- * prices, discount, or terms or conditions of sale;
- * profits, profit margins, or cost data;
- * market shares, sales territories, or markets;
- * allocation of customers, markets or territories
- * discriminatory licensing provisions;
- * standards or certification programs that unreasonably restrain trade;
- * selection, rejection, or termination of customers or supplier;
- * restricting territory or markets in which a company may resell products;
- * restricting the customers to whom a company may sell;
- * bidding or refraining bidding; or
- * any matter which restricts a participants independence in setting prices, establishing production and sales levels, choosing the markets in which the member operates and selects its customers and suppliers.

The principal provisions of the Sherman antitrust laws of the United States provide:

Every contract, combination in the form of trust or otherwise, or conspiracy, in restraint of trade or commerce among the several States, or with foreign nations, is declared to be illegal.
