# IEEE/IAS PULP & PAPER INDUSTRY COMMITTEE ANNUAL CONFERENCE MEETING MINUTES OF THE FULL COMMITTEE VICTORIA CONFERENCE CENTER VICTORIA BC

# **TUESDAY JUNE 29, 2004**

# WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Ron Simpson called the meeting to order at 3:31 PM. He welcomed everyone to Victoria and the Full committee meeting. He then asked everyone in turn to introduce him or herself. Allan Lowe circulated a meeting sign in sheet and asked all attendees to indicate their presence. He also circulated the committee roster for people to make corrections.

# SECRETARY'S REPORT

Blake Lloyd reported that the full committee minutes from Atlanta were sent out on 10/20/03. A motion to approve these minutes as posted was accepted. A permanent web site was used to distribute the minutes and no members reported difficulty in finding the site, or the minutes. A reminder with the URL and passwords will be sent out with these minutes (suggestion by Dave Durocher).

# **EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORT**

Blake Lloyd reported that 22 members were in attendance at the Executive Committee meeting. The meeting was held on Sunday afternoon and resulted in a good discussion on the issues facing this group including conference format and attendance. In an upcoming Operating Guide revision the current Executive Group will be renamed the Operating Group to distinguish themselves from the 5 elected Executive.

# 2003 CHARLESTON CONFERENCE CLOSEOUT REPORT

Rhonda Banks reported the following conference attendance for the Charleston conference: 143 attendees, 49 guests, 109 attended the social, with a room pickup of 79% (the target was 90%). Initially the hotel penalty was to be \$6K which was negotiated down to \$3K which will leave the conference with a small surplus. An audit of the conference will be done when the final checks have cleared.

# TREASURER REPORT/CONFERENCE AUDITS

Dave Durocher reported that all past conferences (except for Charleston) have been audited and are closed.

# STANDING SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

# **MEMBERSHIP**

Alan Lowe reported that our current committee membership is 109. Since the interim meeting in September we have had the following changes in membership: Two (2) members passed away (Kirk Armintor and Del Decker). There three applications pending (Jubin Jackson, Chuck Mozina, Tom Trueb). At the interim meeting we had 42 members present, 33 members requested excused absences and 36 had unexcused absences. A full report is given in the Appendix.

# **MAILING LIST**

John Kay reported that the list continues to be updated. It was suggested and agreed by John that the list should also be printed out by Company Name and Last Name making it easier to find someone in your company to verify.

### PAPER AWARDS AND PUBLICATIONS

Laurie Cihlar reported that we continue to be very successful with papers submitted to transactions and the IAS Magazine. Details are given in the Appendix.

The definition of a "Mill Paper" for awards was clarified and is a paper with ONLY mill authors on it. Should no pure mill papers be available at a particular conference, a paper including a mill author and others will be considered for the Best Mill Paper award.

### **PPIC AWARDS**

Ron Simpson gave a report for the absent Russ Thrift urging everyone to be thinking about candidates deserving of the Engineering and Service Award. He would like subcommittee chairs to use the form in the Operating Guide, along with any other pertinent information available from a candidates resume and peers.

# **FELLOWS NOMINATIONS**

Clayton Reid reported that he is working on an application for Ron Simpson for IEEE Fellow.

# **Liaison Reports**

# PAPTEC (CPPA)

John Kay reported that every year the world's pulp and paper industry meets in Montreal. The fact that the annual meeting of PAPTAC and EXFOR, the parallel pulp and paper equipment show, draw so many influential decision-makers from the paper industry is probably the most significant and noteworthy element of PaperWeek International.

Last year, the 90th Annual PAPTAC Annual Meeting and EXFOR 2004 attracted 9,088 visitors from 25 countries. Also, the Forest Products Association of Canada and the Pulp and Paper Product Councils held open forums attracted another 1,115 individuals, for a grand total of 10,203 participants at PaperWeek International 2004.

There were 1,079 mill attendees representing 168 different mills from 29 countries of the world who experience 417 companies exhibited in EXFOR 2004 as well as almost 200 technical paper presentations! Clearly, this annual event provides an unprecedented number of advanced technology-exchange opportunities for the world's pulp and paper industry.

Plans are already under way for PaperWeek International 2005 which will be held in Montreal from February 7 - 10. The 91st Annual Meeting of PAPTAC will feature close to 200 technical presentations from experts at more than thirty sessions covering a myriad of topics such as mechanical pulping, newsprint, alkaline pulping, research and development, professional development, electrical engineering, instrumentation engineering, process control, fine and coated paper making, bleaching processes just to name a few.

EXFOR 2005 will celebrate its 47th anniversary and will display the latest science and technology devoted to process controls for the manufacturing of pulp, paper and board products. More than 445 Sustaining Members of PAPTAC will have their exhibits spread over 800 booths on site. PaperWeek 2005 and EXFOR will be held the February 7th -10th, 2005

### **IEEE/IAS**

Clayton Reid reminded everyone of the IAS meeting in Seattle coming up. Clayton also suggested we should nominate some of our meritorious engineer and service award winners at the IAS level.

# **TAPPI**

Burt Judson reported TAPPI - PCE&I Division shared in the technical conf. during the Paper Summit, first week of May in Atlanta He expressed disappointment of the PCE&I's decision not to join with the IEEE conference June '05 in Jacksonville (discussed at the Executive meeting).

"Paper Machine Drives" short course to be held Sept 13-15, 2004 at the Holiday Inn Riverwalk, Nennah, WI (sponsored by EE Comm of PCE&I) - Duncan Rhodes is handling the local arrangements and promotion of the short course.

# **IEEE - STANDARDS COORDINATING**

### IEEE SCC 18:

Jim Daly reported that SCC 18 met in January to instruct the votes of the IEEE representatives on the NEC Code Making Panes relative to the actions taken on the public comments for the 2005 NEC. SCC 18 will probably not meet again until Jan. 2006 to instruct the IEEE representatives on the actions to be taken on the proposals for the 2008 NEC. One change in the 2005 NEC of significant impact to the pulp and paper industry is that the 2005 NEC will limit the use of nonshielded cable to 2400V. It will no longer be permitted for 4160V.

### IEEE Standards Projects Committee

There were no standards issued that impacted on the pulp and paper industry.

The Red Book is currently under revision and anyone interested in participating in the revision by electronic means, should contact me and I will provide the contact information.

# Liaison Representative Retirement

Jim Daly announced that he is retiring at the end of this year after 31 active years with PPIC. His successor at General Cable, Richard Barker, has offered to replace Jim in these PPIC liaison activities and the PPIC Chair has accepted the offer.

Finally, Jim expressed his appreciation to all the members of PPIC for making the past 31 years so enjoyable.

# OPERATING SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

# 2004 VICTORIA CONFERENCE REPORT

Mark Weaver reported on the Victoria Conference. The new format – including Vendor Exhibits appears to be working well. Attendance has been good and he hopes to wrap up as a successful conference.

# 2005 - JACKSONVILLE, FL

Rich Butler reported that in 2005 the PPIC conference is on for Jacksonville, FL June 20 to the 24. The hotel is the Adams Mark Hotel on the waterfront which is one of the anchor hotels for the super bowl this year. He and his group are working hard to study this conference and repeat the same format.

# 2006 - Appleton, WI

Duncan Rhodes is in the process of forming a committee for this conference. He will be getting a budget together before the interim meeting for approval.

### 2007 - San Antonio Texas

John Malinowski reported that he is investigating hotels and will likely choose something on the River Walk like the Weston hotel.

# **OLD BUSINESS**

# PERMANENT WEB SITE

As discussed in the last meeting, a permanent committee web site (as well as a permanent current conference site) have been established. The permanent committee site is maintained by Blake, the permanent conference site by the local committee. The Committee site is a repository for past information and current events (assuming Blake keeps it current). Sponsors should make sure that the sub-committee chairmen get a copy of the author's data sheets.

Reviewers should check the official guide to make sure that their role is understood. It is the responsibility of the reviewer to check the paper's accuracy, not to be the editor. The guide is available on the website.

It is also important that the sponsor not only coordinates the reviews of the paper, but also checks the presentation itself to make sure it conforms to IEEE guidelines, especially in the area of avoiding any commercialism. Since the presentations are all in Power Point, they can be easily sent from the author to the sponsor.

It is a requirement that all authors / presenters register for the Conference, even if it is for only one day. This is also true for New Product Presenters.
