IEEE/IAS PULP & PAPER INDUSTRY COMMITTEE INTERIM MEETING MINUTES OF THE FULL COMMITTEE ADAMS MARK HOTEL, JACKSONVILLE, FL

OCTOBER 25, 2004

WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Rory Johnson called the meeting to order at 1:32 PM. He welcomed everyone to Jacksonville and the Interim committee meeting. He then asked everyone in turn to introduce him or herself. Allan Lowe circulated a meeting sign in sheet and asked all attendees to indicate their presence. He also circulated the committee roster for people to make corrections.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

Dave Durocher reported that Blake Lloyd distributed the full committee minutes from Victoria. A motion to approve these minutes as posted was accepted. A permanent web site was used to distribute the minutes and no members reported difficulty in finding the site, or the minutes. A reminder with the URL and passwords will be sent out with these minutes.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORT

Dave Durocher reported that 16 members were in attendance at the Executive Committee meeting. The meeting was held on Sunday evening and resulted in a good discussion on the issues facing this group including conference format and attendance. Select revisions to the Operating Guide were discussed surrounding clarification of awards chair positions and alignment of presentation formats with the existing Author's Guide. Dave Durocher will draft and submit proposed revisions to the Executive Committee for review and approval during the Jacksonville Conference.

2004 VICTORIA CONFERENCE CLOSEOUT REPORT

Blake read from final report write-up from Mark Weaver. The conference was a successful event from a membership standpoint. Conference is not yet closed, audit in not yet complete. Estimate loss of \$2K CAN. This includes expenses of about \$28K on website set-up. Small vendors were happy with the trade fair. A suggestion was made to set-up refreshments in trade fair area. Blake reported that the conference organizer's manual offered by the Victoria Committee is still not ready.

TREASURER REPORT/CONFERENCE AUDITS

Rhonda Banks reported that all past conferences (except for Victoria) have been audited and are closed.

STANDING SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

MEMBERSHIP

Our current committee membership is 115. Since the June 2004 conference, we have 14 new members! Typically the committee sees 3-4 new member registrations at the annual conference. Alan felt that the increase was directly attributable to the new conference format, which enabled perspective new members to get involved in the subcommittee meetings. At the Victoria Conference we had 68 members present, 21 excused absences, 20 unexcused absences, 3 retired and 5 dropped.

Regarding marketing future conferences. Charlie Canty reported during the Executive Meeting that the ad-hoc committee to improve conference attendance had worked to change the conference format. The new format was well received, so the ad-hoc committee has disbanded. Looking forward, Dave Durocher reported that a new committee was recently formed. Dave will chair the new *Awareness Committee*, focused on improving conference attendance of industry engineers (both from mills and corporate engineering). The thought being that strong industry engineer attendance is the key driver for sustained conference attendance growth. Volunteer members of this new committee include John Malinowski, Rich Butler, Rhonda Banks, Jim Williams and Rob Boltener. The local chairman for the next annual conference (in this case Duncan Rhodes) automatically becomes a member.

Student attendance was discussed. Rich Butler committed to talk to Bob Lorenz on ideas and also to contact engineering schools at UNF Jacksonville and UF Gainesville.

MAILING LIST

John Kay reported that the mailing list updates continue, including many changes from Victoria conference. We have removed 400-500 names in past 2 years. At present, about 2000 names remain on the current list. We are adding emails as they become available. Since this is a moving target, John again left list for group to review. Rory Johnson stressed the use of the IEEE alias as a means of keeping email addresses current. This is easy to use and if your email address changes, it's simple to change the pointer to a new email address. Our most current email mailing list for the membership is on the committee website. The mailing list is the key for us for future conferences and one area we are striving to address with Awareness Committee. If you know people in your company that should be added, let the committee know.

PUBLICITY

Ron Meihofer had nothing new to report at this meeting. The November IEEE IAS Magazine will have information on the upcoming conference.

PAPER AWARDS AND PUBLICATIONS

Laurie Cihlar was not able to attend the interim meeting. The Executive Committee reported that we continue to be very successful with papers submitted to transactions and the IAS Magazine. Updated details are given in the Appendix.

Repeating from previous meeting minutes, the definition of a "Mill Paper" for awards was clarified as a paper with ONLY mill authors. Should no pure mill papers be available at a particular conference, a paper including a mill author and others will be considered for the Best Mill Paper award.

PPIC AWARDS

Russ Thrift again congratulated Roger Jones, winner of the 2004 Meritorious Engineering Award and Larry Thomas, winner of the 2004 Meritorious Service Award. The committee is soliciting nominations for 2005 awards. The Operating guide and appendix explains what information is required to submit a nomination including the necessary forms. At the time of the meeting, Russ had received two nominations, awaiting further information on one of the nominees. Rory

Johnson reminded the group that award recipients do not need to be a member of the committee as explained in the Operating Guide.

FELLOWS NOMINATIONS

John Kay reported that the committee is working on an application for Ron Simpson for IEEE Fellow.

Liaison Reports

PAPTEC (CPPA)

John Kay reported that every year the world's pulp and paper industry meets in Montreal. PAPTAC (formerly CPPA) is scheduled February 7-10, 2005. The conference will feature technical sessions in several areas of engineering disciplines, including electrical. Held in conjunction with this conference is the EXFOR 2005 Trade Fair, planned to feature over 800 booths. Last year, over 1000 mill participants attended from 417 mill locations and 29 countries. 200 technical papers were presented.

IEEE/IAS

The Annual IEEE IAS Conference was held in Seattle Oct 4-7, 2004. There were just over 700 registered attendees. Two awards were proudly issued to members of the PPIC Committee. The First Prize IAS Transactions paper award went to Robert D. Lorenz, Anibal Valenzuela and John M. Bentley for the March/April 2003 paper "Sensorless Tension Control in Paper Machines". The Second Prize IAS Magazine paper award went to Charles J. Mozina and Douglas C. Moody for the March/April 2003 paper "Benefits of Upgrading Paper Mill Generator Protection". Congratulations to our members. Clayton Reid has been appointed the IAS Process Industries Chairman. This position represents IAS industry committees including Pulp & Paper, Petrochemical, Metals, Mining and Cement industries.

TAPPI

Burt Judson reported TAPPI - PCE&I Division planned to again share in the technical conference with the TAPPI Papermaking Division during the week of May 23-26 in Milwaukee, WI.

The "Paper Machine Drives Short Course" was held Sept 13-15, 2004 at the Holiday Inn Riverwalk, Nennah, WI (sponsored by EE Committee of PCE&I). Duncan Rhodes and Pete Werner handled the local arrangements and promotion of the short course. 25 engineers attended this successful event.

IEEE - STANDARDS COORDINATING

IEEE SCC 18:

Jim Daly reported that SCC 18 had not met since January 2004. The next meeting will be held the 1st week in January 2005.

IEEE Standards Projects Committee

There were no standards issued that impacted on the pulp and paper industry.

IEEE Electrical Safety Workshop

Larry Thomas reported that the 12th Annual IEEE Industry Applications Society Electrical Safety Workshop was planned for February 8-11, 2005 at the Denver Marriott Tech Center Hotel in Denver, Colorado. Workshop website is: www.ewh.ieee.org/cmte/ias-esw/

2004 VICTORIA CONFERENCE REPORT

Blake Lloyd reported for Mark Weaver on the Victoria Conference. The new format – including Vendor Exhibits appears to have worked well. Attendance was good although participation from local mills was somewhat disappointing.

FUTURE CONFERENCES

2005 - JACKSONVILLE, FL

Rich Butler reported that in 2005 the PPIC conference is set for Jacksonville, FL June 20 to the 24. The hotel is the Adams Mark Hotel on the waterfront, which is one of the anchor hotels for the super bowl last year. The technical program sessions will take place on the hotel 2nd floor. The local committee plans to get quotes and value statements from kill engineers to add to the conference web site. The Social theme is "Old Florida" and the Guest Program will highlight St. Augustine FL and Amelia Island. Our Keynote Speaker will be Frank Cepolline, Deputy Associate Director of the Goddard Space Flight Center in Greenbelt, Maryland. The conference technical theme is "Managing Projects on a large/grand scale".

2006 - Appleton, WI

Dave Rollay reported for Duncan Rhodes. The 2006 Conference will be held at the Radisson Paper Valley Hotel, June 18-22, 2006 in Appleton. We have an active local committee, an approved budget and a hotel contract in place.

2007 - Williamsburg, VA

John Malinowski reported that the 2007 committee has set a contract with the Williamsburg Lodge, with full access to Williamsburg Historic District. 2007 is the 400th anniversary of Jamestown, so this will be a historic year with plenty of activities. Reenactments will take place throughout the city. John is considering Thomas Jefferson as Keynote speaker. Dates are June 24-28, 2007.

2008 - Birmingham, AL

Robert Adams reported that at present, the 2008 conference is scheduled to be held in Birmingham, Alabama.

Charlie Canty reported no progress beyond the new conference format. We will use this format for several years to gauge the impact on attendance. The Awareness Committee will continue moving forward in our efforts to improve our annual conference attendance.

Mark Weaver is Conference Publications chairman for the IEEE IAS. Mark is requesting Committee Publications Chairman that can track papers, etc. The Committee will look at making a change to the operation guide, confirm what duties of this position would be and send to committee for approval.
