# IEEE/IAS PULP & PAPER INDUSTRY COMMITTEE 2005 PPIC CONFERENCE MINUTES OF THE FULL COMMITTEE HYATT REGENCY HOTEL, JACKSONVILLE, FL

**JUNE 21, 2005** 

#### WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Rory Johnson called the meeting to order at 3:35 PM. He welcomed everyone to Jacksonville and the Conference Full committee meeting. He then asked everyone in turn to introduce him or herself. Allan Lowe circulated a meeting sign in sheet and asked all attendees to indicate their presence. He also circulated the committee roster for people to make corrections. Rory mentioned that the quality of the papers for this year's conference has been excellent. Suggested that all be sure to acknowledge/congratulate and thank the authors. Authors obviously committed quite a bit of time in preparation - sometimes we forget about this.

#### SECRETARY'S REPORT

Dave Durocher reported that the full committee minutes from the Jacksonville Interim Meeting were distributed by Rory Johnson to all committee members via email on June 6, 2005 and were also posted on the committee website. A motion to approve these minutes as posted was accepted. The permanent web site was used to distribute the minutes and no members reported difficulty in finding the site, or the minutes. A reminder with the URL and password is included in these minutes under Old Business.

#### **EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORT**

Dave Durocher reported that 13 members were in attendance at the Executive Committee meeting. The meeting was held on Sunday from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM and resulted in a good discussion on the issues facing this group. Select proposed revisions to the Operating Guide were discussed and approved by the Executive Committee. Changes involved clarification of awards chair positions and alignment of presentation formats with the existing Author's Guide.

#### 2004 VICTORIA CONFERENCE CLOSEOUT REPORT

Mark Weaver, Victoria Conference Chair, was not in attendance at the meeting. The conference was a successful event from a membership standpoint. Could not confirm if the Victoria Conference was closed or if the audit was complete. Estimate loss of \$2K CDN. This includes expenses of about \$28K CDN on website set-up. The proposed conference organizer's manual offered by the Victoria Committee is still not ready. John Kay has agreed to take on the task of working to create this document.

#### TREASURER REPORT/CONFERENCE AUDITS

Rhonda Banks reported that all past conferences have been audited and are closed. Rhonda was not sure about Victoria being closed.

#### STANDING SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

#### **MEMBERSHIP**

Our current committee membership is 119. Since the interim meeting in October we have had the following changes in membership: Four new members joined the committee including Rob Boteler, Cyndi Gates, Mike Kozlowski and Brian Winter. At the interim meeting we had 30 members present, 72 members requested excused absences and 13 had unexcused absences. An updated attendance roster is appended to these minutes.

#### **MAILING LIST**

John Kay reported that he received no changes or feedback from the Victoria committee regarding the accuracy of the database sent to them several months before the event. So, we have utilized their registration list, along with the published list changes and revisions made at the conference, to update our database. This year we had a strong group of individuals focusing their time on scrubbing down the present mailing list. We focused a good portion of our energy on the large corporate companies and specifically scrubbing down email addresses. John acknowledged several individuals for their time and support to update the database including: Dave Durocher, Rich Butler, Rhonda Banks, Russ Ford, Duncan Rhodes and Bob Jordan. John suggested he was sure there are others who have channeled info back through these people as well – Thank you! We removed approximately 300 names deemed obsolete or inaccurate. Over 275 addresses were changed or revised to include email addresses. We added about 75 new contacts this year. Our current list now includes 1935 addresses of which 726 have email addresses (Current to date!!). Printed lists are again available for revisions at the conference.

#### **PUBLICITY**

Ron Meihofer was not present and due to retirement has resigned from the Publicity Chair position. Rory announced that Rob Boteler has volunteered to fill this position. Due to this position transition, our committee missed the window in reporting the Jacksonville conference to the appropriate trade publications.

#### PAPER AWARDS AND PUBLICATIONS

Laurie Cihlar outlined some of the discussion from the Executive Committee meeting clarifying the process for paper publication. She mentioned that several conversations from our committee and others in IAS prompted and editorial in the Jan/Feb IAS Magazine by Louie Powell. Laurie clarified that in our committee, reviewers make recommendations for publishing. It is not automatic that submitted = published. Laurie described paper selection criteria for IAS Magazine versus Transactions.

#### **PPIC AWARDS**

Russ Thrift congratulated Jay Das, winner of the 2005 Meritorious Engineering Award and Alan Lowe, winner of the 2005 Meritorious Service Award. He encouraged those present to "shower the recipients with love". The committee is soliciting nominations for 2006 awards. Regarding new nominations, Alan suggested that all committee members begin to think about deserving recipients. Take on the challenge of nominating someone now instead of waiting until the last minute. The recently updated Operating Guide and appendix explains what information is required to submit a nomination including the necessary forms.

#### **FELLOWS NOMINATIONS**

Clayton Reid – announced that the committee has submitted two nominations for IEEE Fellow: Jim Rooks & Ron Simpson. Final election will take place in November – we are encouraged so far. Regarding IEEE awards, Clayton congratulated Bob Lorenz who was recently recognized at the IAS Annual Conference with an IEEE award. All should be looking at submitting candidates for IEEE awards. Regarding Senior Members – IEEE now has just over 26,000. Retention rate for seniors is 97%, only 84% for members. Clayton once again announced that IAS membership was free at the conference. If you are a member of the committee, you are required to join IAS. He mentioned Greg Drewiske who was asked if he wanted to attend a subcommittee meeting. He did and is now Vice Chairman!

#### **Liaison Reports**

#### PAPTAC (CPPA)

John Kay reported that this year, the 91st Annual PAPTAC Annual Meeting and EXFOR 2005 attracted 8,681 visitors from over 30 countries. Also, the Forest Products Association of Canada and the Pulp and Paper Product Councils held open forums attracted another 1,002 individuals, for a grand total of 9,683 participants at PaperWeek International 2005. There were over 1,000 mill attendees representing 179 different mills -124 Canadian and 55 from 29 countries of the world who experience exhibits from 392 companies at EXFOR 2005 as well they had the choice of being engaged in almost 200 technical paper presentations.

Plans are already under way for PaperWeek International 2006, which will be held in Montreal from February 6 - 9, 2006. The 92nd Annual Meeting of PAPTAC will again feature close to 200 technical presentations from experts in

more than thirty sessions covering a myriad of topics such as mechanical pulping, newsprint, alkaline pulping, research and development, professional development, electrical engineering, instrumentation engineering, process control, fine and coated paper making, bleaching processes just to name a few. EXFOR 2006 will celebrate its 48th anniversary of displaying the latest science and technology devoted solely to process controls for the manufacturing of pulp, paper and board products.

#### **IEEE/IAS**

The Annual IEEE IAS Conference will be held in Hong Kong China Oct 2-6, 2005. Clayton Reid continues as IAS Process Industries Chairman. This position represents IAS industry committees including Pulp & Paper, Petrochemical, Metals, Mining and Cement industries.

#### **TAPPI**

Burt Judson reported TAPPI - PCE&I Division shared in the technical conference with the TAPPI Papermaking Division during the week of May 22-26 in Milwaukee, WI. Many members of the IEEE also attend the TAPPI sessions. There were 4 people total that attended from the Electrical Committee. A very disappointing turnout.

#### **IEEE - STANDARDS COORDINATING**

IEEE SCC 18:

Rich Barker reported that SCC 18 have not met. The next meeting is scheduled for January 2005.

*IEEE Standards Projects Committee*No standards are presently being processed.

#### **IEEE ELECTRICAL SAFETY WORKSHOP**

Larry Thomas reported that the 13th Annual IEEE Industry Applications Society Electrical Safety Workshop is planned for February 7-10, 2005 at the Philadelphia Downtown Marriott Hotel in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Workshop website is:

#### OPERATING SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

Detailed reports from the 4 standing subcommittees are appended.

#### 2005 JACKSONVILLE CONFERENCE REPORT

Rich Butler offered a preliminary report for the Jacksonville Conference. Financially the event appears to be doing very well. Rich was close to ready to forecast the conference would be in the black. He thanked the authors – this is the value of the conference. Rich reported that in early April there were significant problems getting the website going but problems were resolved quickly. The hotel ownership transition has worked out well. 166 total registration as of this report. The guest program includes visits to St. Augustine & Amelia Island. All guests are welcome to join us for the awards program Wednesday. Thanks for staying at the conference hotel as we made our room block commitment, which helps the conference financing.

#### 2006 TECHNICAL PROGRAM

Blake Lloyd reviewed the summary of proposed 2006 technical papers from the Operating Subcommittees. As of this time, we have 11 A papers and 13 B papers or 25 total A's and B's for the Appleton Conference. Blake is trying to target for 28-30 papers for next year's technical program. He stressed that papers accepted for the 2006 program would be on a first come-first served basis.

#### **FUTURE CONFERENCES**

#### 2006 - Appleton, WI

Duncan Rhodes reported that the 2006 PPIC Conference will be held at the Radisson Paper Valley Hotel, June 18-22, 2006 in Appleton, Wisconsin. We have an active local committee, an approved budget and a hotel contract in place. The Paper Valley hotel room rate is - \$90/night. Tours will include the EAA Experimental Aircraft Museum. Appleton is a great town 80,000 people, 6 airlines fly into the local airport. The local committee is looking for heavy mill attendance. Bill Polley is assigned to get names of local mill engineers from local vendors. Packets covering Appleton are available to pick up in the back of the room during this conference.

#### 2007 - Williamsburg, VA

John Malinowski reported that the 2007 committee has set a contract with the Williamsburg Lodge, with full access to Williamsburg Historic District. 2007 is the 400<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Jamestown, so this will be a historic year with plenty of activities. Reenactments will take place throughout the city. John is considering Thomas Jefferson as Keynote speaker. Dates are June 24-28, 2007.

John Malinowski reported that the committee has a contract in place with the Williamsburg Lodge, on the property of Colonial Williamsburg. This is a new facility and conference center. The Interim Meeting is scheduled Oct 22-23, 2006. The Conference dates are June 24-28, 2007. 2007 is the 400<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Jamestown, so this will be a historic year with plenty of activities. Ideas for the social – Williamsburg is 90 miles from Washington DC. Perhaps a day trip to Busch Gardens in Jamestown. Still working to find a Guest Speaker. The Social on Wednesday – A Groaning Feast. 1700's style food with historic characters and reenactments. Rooms will be less than \$170. Still looking for help finding members for the local committee.

#### 2008 - Birmingham, AL

Robert Adams reported that the 2008 conference in Birmingham, Alabama has been moved to 2009. Rory suggested Seattle for 2008. Robert reported that Paul Rouleit has agreed to be on the local committee. Will also try to get Preston Jackson to help.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

#### PERMANENT WEB SITE

Blake Lloyd offered an update on the permanent website. He plans to open a local committee hand-off area and eventually a history area based on big box from Jim Rooks. There is a link at the bottom of the web page "link to FTP site". This will be visible to all committee members that know the password – "handsomeblake". The URL to this site is

This site will remain the host for the annual conference, presently managed by the Appleton Conference Committee.

Blake discussed web site hosting costs from the past two conferences. The most difficult (and costly) part is dealing with transactional items that handle money. At present, the local conference committees are spending too much for these services. Perhaps the Appleton committee should consider going back to a manual database similar to that used in Toronto and Charleston. Blake committed to get some ideas and a template from PCIC.

#### **CONFERENCE ATTENDANCE/AWARENESS COMMITTEE**

Dave Durocher discussed progress made by the Awareness Committee and offered a brief presentation. Highlights of activities over the past year:

July 21, 2004 Sent conference follow-up letter to all participating industry engineers that attended the Victoria & Charleston conferences. Each letter included a Victoria Conference Record on CD. The Victoria letter was mailed to Victoria conference attendees, expressing appreciation for attending and asking that the extra CD be distributed to a fellow engineer that might be interested in attending next year.

The Charleston letter was mailed to Charleston conference attendees that missed the Victoria

conference, expressing regrets that we missed their attendance and were offering a free Conference

Record CD in hopes that we would see them next year.

March 2005 Completed effort in developing/validating 338 industry engineer email addresses

April 6, 2005 Emailed "Did you know" letter to list developed above, promising that attending the conference

would help to 1) establish technical relationships, 2) enhance technical knowledge, 3) meet world-renowned experts, 4) share best industry practices, 5) complete employer's continued education requirements, 6) earn credit hours to retain a Professional Engineering license all while 7)

minimizing time away from the mill.

May 24, 2005 Sent same group of industry engineers a list of papers & Jacksonville hotel extension update.

Plans are underway to send a reminder letter to the target industry engineer list with a sample of Appleton 2006 planned technical papers by the end of October 2005. Many thanks to key members of the Awareness Committee in helping to establish the target list of industry engineers including Bob Jordan, Russ Ford and Rhonda Banks as well as John Kay for his patience in several revisions to the committee mailing list.

#### **INTERIM MEETING**

Dave Rollay reported that the 2006 Interim meeting is scheduled at the Radisson Paper Valley Hotel in Appleton, Wisconsin on October 23-24, 2006.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

#### **CONFERENCE PUBLICATION CHAIRMAN**

Mark Weaver is Conference Publications chairman for the IEEE IAS. Mark is requesting Committee Publications Chairman that can track papers, etc. Rory will work with Mark to get clarification on changes from the IAS and will develop a position description and then fill the position.

#### **NEW SUBCOMMITTEE CHAIR POSITIONS**

Rory recognized the outgoing chairman including Larry Menche – EMMC, Duncan Rhodes – DCS, Bucky Hammonds – PDS and Jim Williams – TSSC. New subcommittee chairs staring after July 2005 include Larry Menche – EMMC, John Malinowski – DCS, Robert Adams – PDS and Tim Crnco – TSSC.

#### **CLOSING ANNOUNCEMENTS AND REMARKS**

Rory announced that with Duncan taking over as chairman for the Appleton Conference, we are looking for a volunteer to take over as presentation coordinator.

Rory announced that he is looking to try to form a committee to improve student participation at the conference. Bob Lorenz would be willing to serve on this committee. Chuck Mozina clarified that the Charleston prize paper awards from his work on Generator Grounding went to support students to attend the I&CPS Conference.

Duncan suggested that we get the minutes out earlier. So noted.

Rory closed by discussing the future of our committee and annual conference. The value of the committee cannot be calculated. Rory proposed to establish a small ad-hoc committee to set long range goals of the PPIC. Clayton made the point that "What's good for the users is good for the vendors". A suggestion was made to select members that think this way and that have a genuine passion in assuring that the committee/conference has a future.
