1. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS – ALEX WU

Alex called the meeting to order at 2:05 PM EDT. Approximately 24 members were in attendance on the conference call

2. REVIEW/APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF CONFERENCE MEETING – GREG DREWISKE

Greg reported that the full committee general meeting minutes, held in Charlotte, were distributed via email to those of the committee and these same minutes were posted on the committee website www.pulpandpapercommittee.com. Greg noted that one change was noted and has been corrected. Dave Durocher moved to approve the minutes and the motion was seconded by Larry Oleson. The minutes were approved by the full committee.

3. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORT – GREG DREWISKE

Greg reported that 7 members were in attendance at the Executive Committee meeting held Friday, October 4th at 11:00am EDT

Some of the highlights of interest that were discussed:

- a) Proposal to combine the Secretary and Treasurer into one Secretary/Treasurer position
- b) Changes to the Rooks Program were discussed to possibly attract new industry engineers to conference. Possibility of full scholarships paid by the conference were also discussed.

4. TREASURER'S REPORT/CONFERENCE AUDITS

The 2012 IEEE IAS Pulp & Paper Conference final audit was successfully completed in April. The overall surplus for this conference was \$42,876! A request to transfer 33% (\$14,292.74) of surplus to the Oregon Section was submitted for processing on Friday, April 26, 2013 with the balance retained by the IEEE IAS. A very successful conference. 186 total registered, 50 mill engineers!

To be considered for nomination,

1. You must hold a Senior Member grade at the time the nomination is submitted and shall have been a member in good standing in any grade for a period of five years or more preceding 1 January of the year of elevation. If you're not a senior member it's time to also consider an application.
2. You also need a nominator who does NOT need to be a Fellow.
3. You need a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 8 current Fellows to act as your references.

Nominations can be submitted for our committee members with sponsorship from this technical committee, or through the other various IEEE IAS Societies.

Nominations will be accepted for the IEEE Fellows class of 2014 up to the deadline of 1 March 2014. If you believe someone from within the ranks is worthy of this nomination, please speak to me. 6. CHARLOTTE CONFERENCE REPORT – ROLY ROBERGE

The financial report for Charlotte is being finalized. All of the charges have been received and Rhonda and Roly are reviewing the budget inputs for submittal to IEEE. It looks like the Charlotte conference will have a contribution of 23 % with verses a target of 20%. The total revenue of the conference was \$123K with a contribution of approximately \$29K.

9. OLD BUSINESS

a) AD HOC – SUSTAINABILITY – DAVE DUROCHER

Sustainability Ad-Hoc: We again sent outreach emails to our mailing list. Two emails, a “Save The Date” on 03/11/13 and an “Early Bird Registration Extended” email on 04/27/13. Our email list is growing – current count is 1385 valid email addresses, both mill and consultants/vendors. We are also tracking mill/industry engineers attending the conference. I will have the final numbers for this year for the Tuesday meeting. 46 Mill Engineers in Charlotte, 50 in Portland.

c) AD HOC - COMMITTEE FOR THE JAMES A. ROOKS MEMORIAL INTERN PROGRAM– GREG DREWISKE

One Intern was present for the 2013 Charlotte Conference:
Jonathan Green – IP – Georgetown, SC

- What did you like Most about the Conference?
I really liked the diversity of engineers and people that I was able to meet on this trip. Though most of them much older than me
- What did you like Least about the Conference?
Some of the topics were a little too technical for me where they started to tread in some areas that were of no interest to me or they were beyond my current understanding.
- What could be improved?
I don't where you could do this, but maybe add a segment or this could be having the intern(s) completely separate from the group and discuss and maybe show some of the various types of work that are possible to get into. I've heard about some things from other engineers, but I have yet to see any of it in my personal experiences. For instance with this internship I've been doing more desk work and not a ton of field/hands-on work like I'd like, but several engineers have told me working in the Pulp and Paper Industry there are many opportunities for it.
- Did this change your view of the Pulp and Paper Industry?
Not enough to matter. While it was a great conference, it did not do much for changing how I see the industry, however I did enjoy the opportunity to see how IEEE operates. This was my first conference as a member, and I hope to attend a different next year.

d) JAMES A. ROOKS MEMORIAL CONTRIBUTIONS – DAVE DUROCHER

JA Rooks Program: The account is doing well, current balance is \$140,821. With our present initiative to support up to 4 students at \$2000 each, I believe the

balance puts us into a mode of being sustainable over the long term. We are still taking contributions and should push for support at the annual conference as we have in the past 6 years. We have supplemented the intern costs using the Myron T Zucker Funds for intern travel in past years, beginning this year we will only use funds from the JA Rooks account. We have one intern this year – Jonathan Green, International paper Georgetown SC.

e) CONFERENCE SURVEY – GREG DREWISKE

10. NEW BUSINESS

a) WEBINAR REVIEW:

b) ROOKS PROGRAM CHANGES:

We had some discussion around potential changes to the Rooks program and/or other means to try and attract young industry engineers. Dave Durocher presented the following motion to the IAS board to help get things started. Greg will work to formalize the application process. The thought was we might get more bang for the buck if we can attract some younger engineers who are already in the industry.

Motion to adopt support of a new Young Engineers initiative by the IAS PPIC:

In an effort to encourage attendance of Young Engineers at the 2014 IEEE IAS PPIC Conference June 15-19, 2014 in Atlanta GA, the PPIC Executive Committee requests funding from the IAS Board for a total of US \$6,000 to be transferred into the conference concentration bank account prior to 12/31/2013. These funds will support a new Young Engineers initiative to pay for travel/registration and hotel expenses to attend the 2014 IEEE IAS PPIC Conference, reimbursing expenses up to US \$2000 for up to three (3) Young Engineers. Eligible candidates would include a) Engineers employed full time by forest products industry end-user or consultant b) Engineers working in the industry less than 5 years and who have never attended PPIC Conference and c) Engineers who are under 30 years of age. Candidates will submit application to the Committee Treasurer, and those selected will be required to attend subcommittee and full committee meetings during the conference. Expenses will

be reimbursed via approved submission using the 2014 IEEE IAS expense report. Any unused funds remaining in the conference budget will be returned to the IAS as a part of the surplus after the conference is closed.

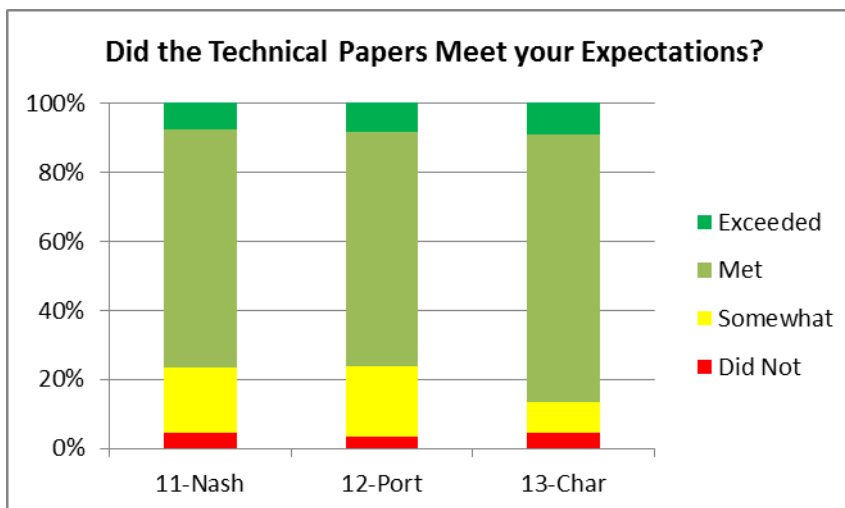

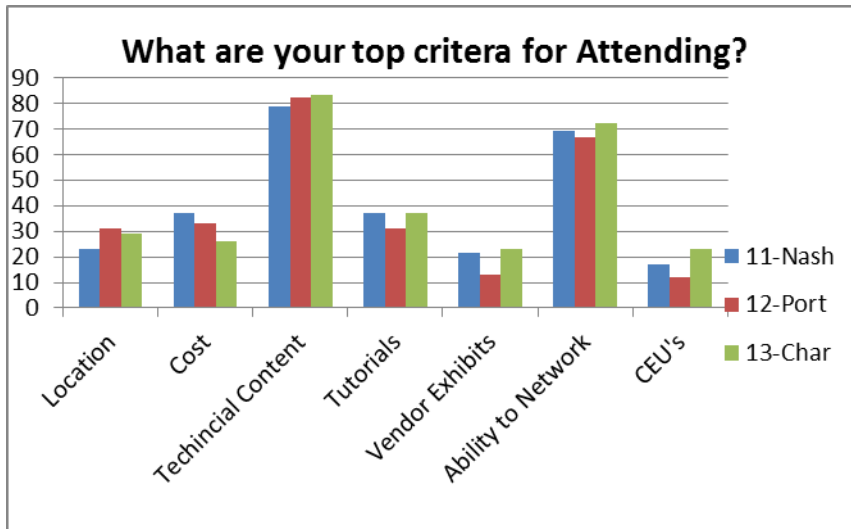

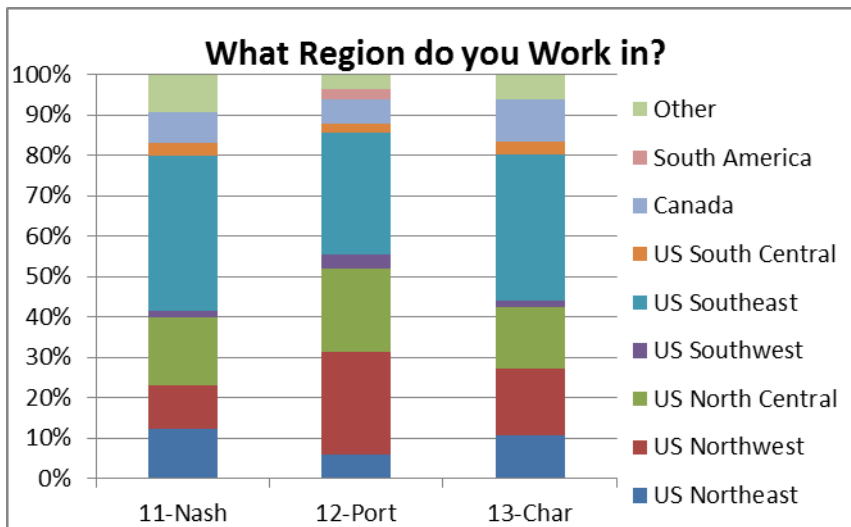

5. How many years experience do you have in the Forest Products Industry?



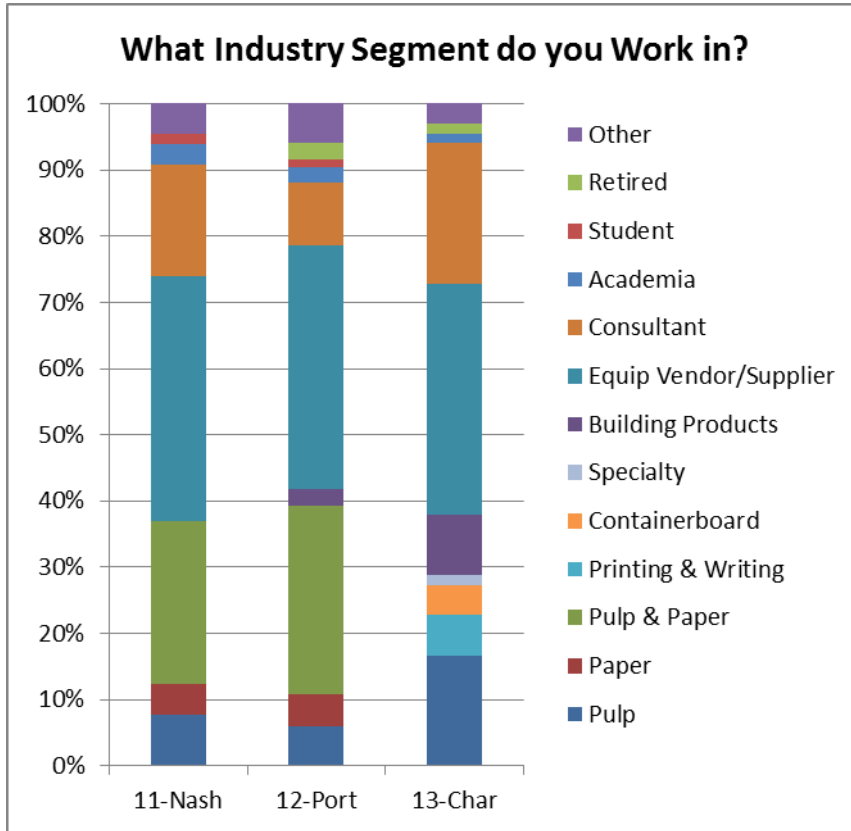
6. What region do you work in?



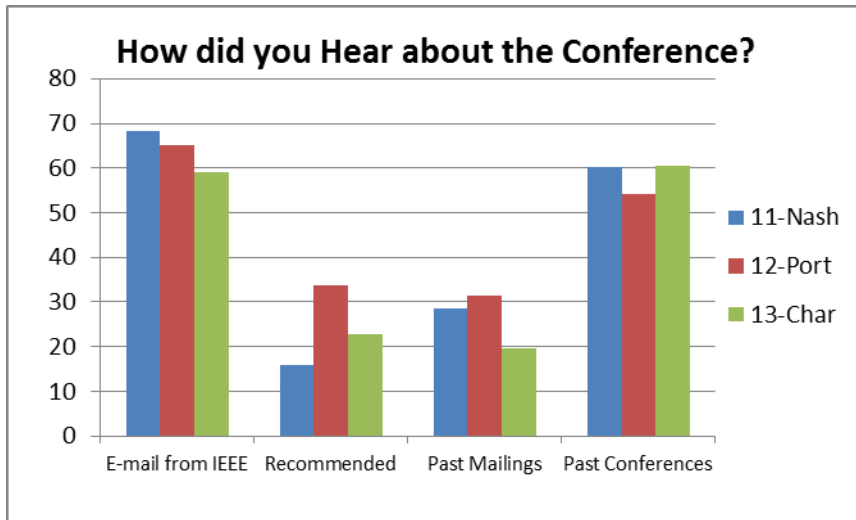

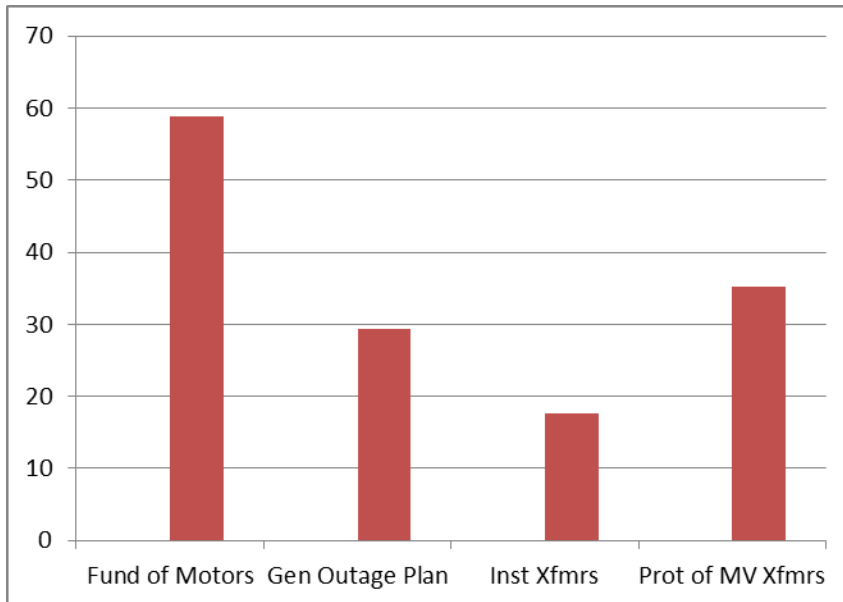

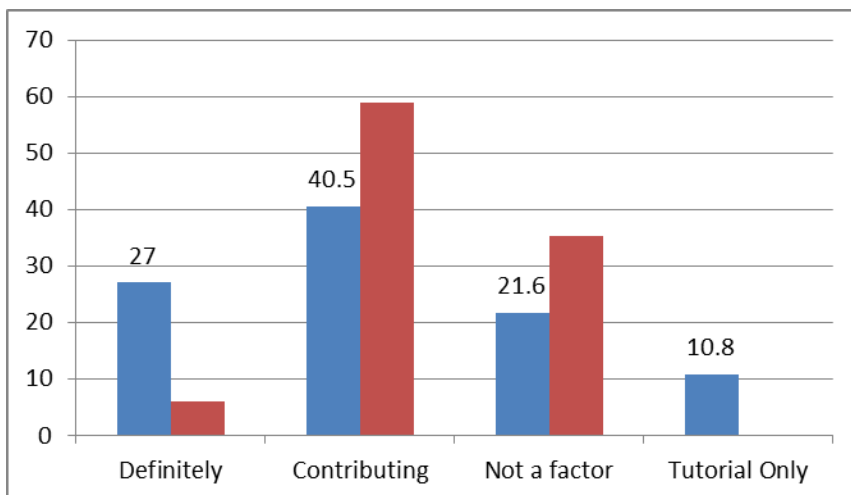

11. Which Tutorial did you attend?



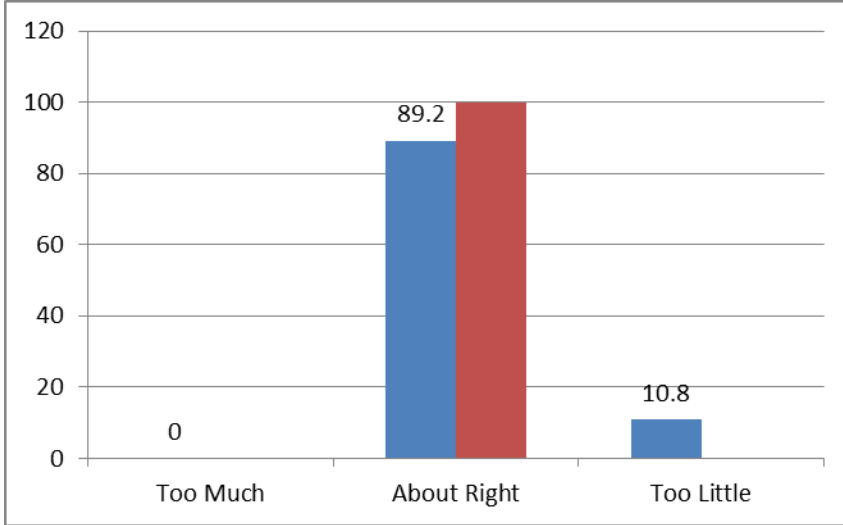
12. Was the Tutorial a factor in your decision to attend the IEEE PPIC Conference?



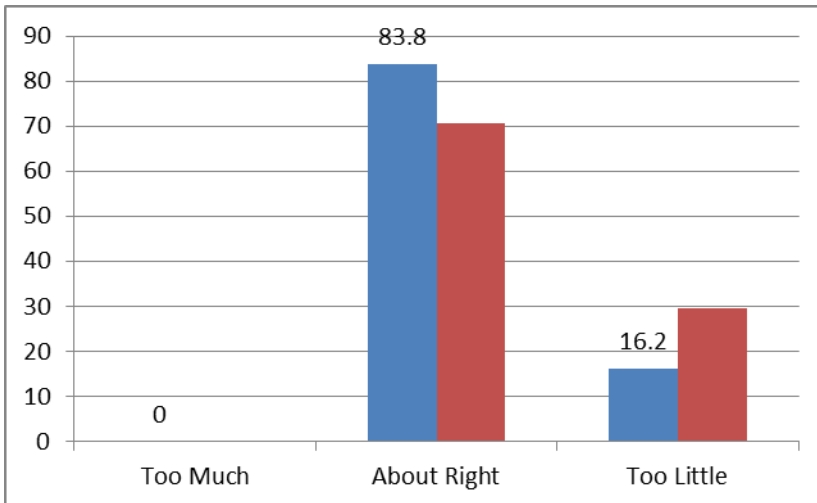

13. In your Tutorial, was the information presented in sufficient depth to satisfy your needs and expectations?



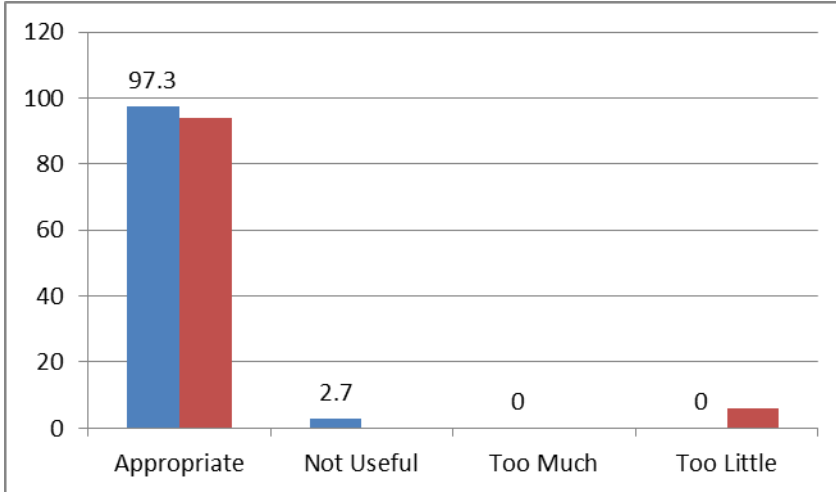
14. In your Tutorial, was there adequate time for discussion and questions-and-answer activity?



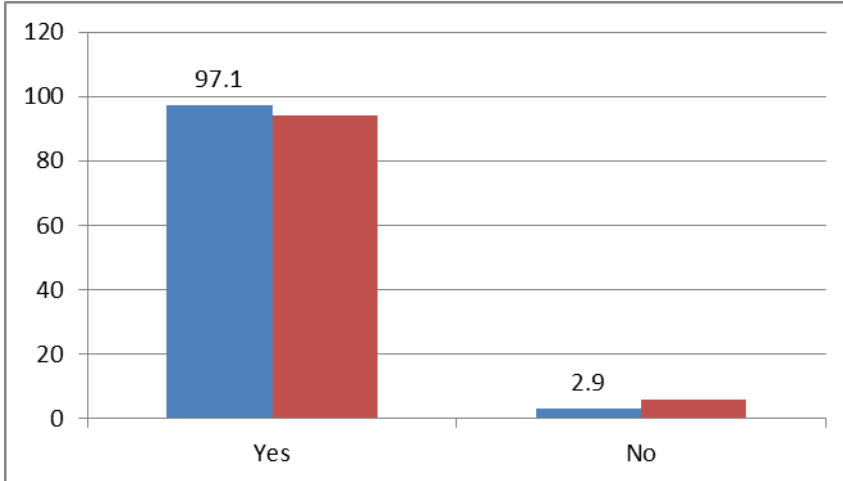

15. Did you receive adequate and useful text and note material to support the tutorial and to be useful for future needs?



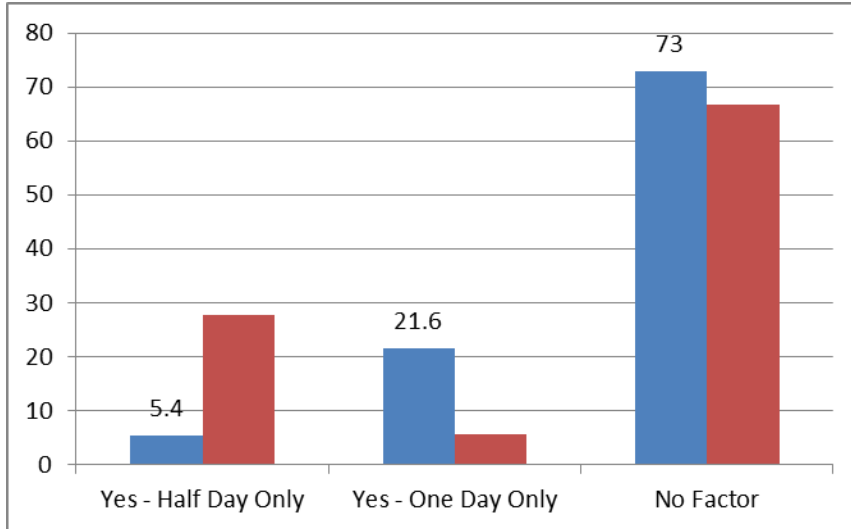
16. Were the facilities (A-V, room and table space, seating setup and break provisions) adequate?



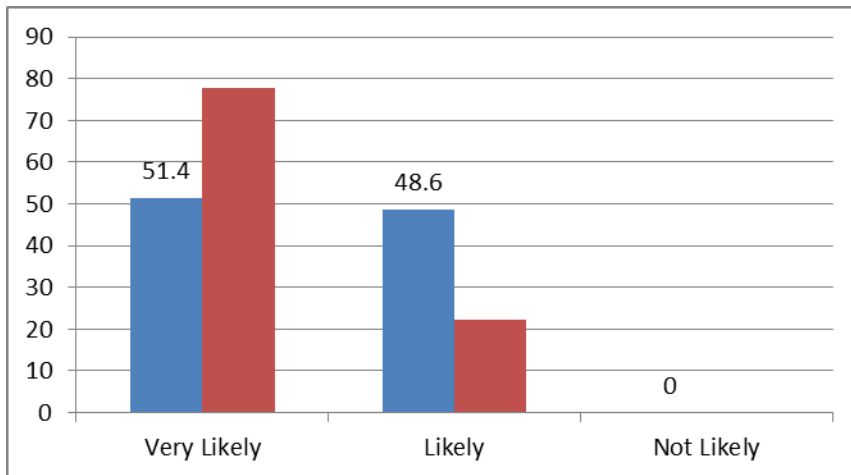

17. There were tutorials of different duration offered. Was the duration a factor in your choice of which tutorial to attend?



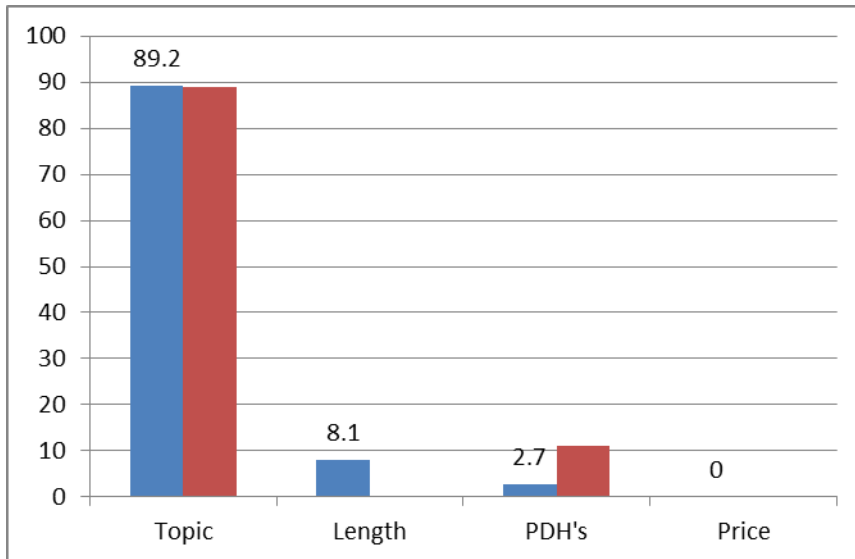
