The Memphis Chapter of the Tennessee Society of Professional Engineers is proud to present a two hour lunch time presentation on making ethical decisions that can be defended. Attendees will receive a certificate of attendance certifying two Professional Development Hours of continuing education on the topic of ethics.

OBJECTIVES

The workshop will include defining “ethics” “right conduct” and “dilemma”. A method to achieve ethical decisions that we can defend will be presented. Ethical responsibilities of practicing engineers will be reviewed. The NSPE Code of Ethics and the Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Board of Architectural and Engineering Examiners will be reviewed and compared. Disciplinary actions by the State Board of Architectural and Engineering Examiners for violations of the Code of Professional Conduct will be reviewed. The workshop will conclude with an ethical problem solving exercise.

This presentation is developed for all professional engineers, professional land surveyors, architects and landscape architects. Managers and administrators are encouraged to attend.
