1.0 Introduction

The SC-2 Chairman, Satish Aggarwal, opened the meeting on Wednesday April 20, 2005 at 8:00 am and welcomed everyone in attendance. This meeting was scheduled for 1½ days; concluding Thursday April 21. A role call was taken and it was determined that a quorum was available, with 47 of 71 SC-2 members present, or represented by proxy.

1.1 General Remarks, Review and Approval of Agenda

The Chairman indicated the next meeting (05-2) would be held in either Fort Lauderdale, FL or Miami, FL and the 06-1 meeting would be held in Atlanta, GA. There were no objections or comments noted on either location. Furthermore, the chairman indicated that SC 2 meetings would continue to be held separate from the NPEC meetings due to the logistics of coordinating the meetings.

The Chairman reiterated his goal to have all SC 2 standards approved by the end of 2006.

The meeting agenda (Attachment 1) was reviewed and no changes were requested. A motion was made by Nissen Burstein to approve the meeting agenda. Jim Parello seconded the motion and the SC-2 members approved the agenda unanimously.

2.0 Review and Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

The minutes of the previous SC-2 meeting 04-2 were opened for comment by the members. Hearing none, a motion was made to approve the minutes by Nissen Burstein, seconded by Jim Gleason and the minutes were approved unanimously.

2.1 Alligator Fund

The alligator fund is made up of voluntary contributions from SC-2 members to defray the cost of meeting rooms, refreshments, and other meeting expenses. The balance prior to meeting 04-2 was \$1400. An amount of \$220 was paid by working Group SC2.1 for the 4-02 meeting in Las Vegas, bringing the total to \$1620. Expenses for 04-02 were \$1056 (paid to the Flamingo Hotel, Las Vegas-see financial summary in Attachment 2 as audited by Nissen Burstein). The total charges billed by the San Diego Marriott for the 05-01 meeting were \$1297.26 (\$873.53 for April 20, 2005 and \$423.73 for April 21, 2005).

The balance after expenses as of Jan 2005 was \$494.

A contribution of \$30.00 was requested from each of the members for this meeting. Of the 36 members physically present at the meeting, 36 contributed the requested \$30. In addition, 5 member's proxy contributed \$30 for the absent members, and 3 guests contributed \$30. A total of \$1,320 was collected bringing the total fund to \$1814. These funds are held by the Chairman, SC-2.

3.0 SC-2 Chairman's Report

3.1 SC-2 Activities

The Chairman then reviewed the goal of issuing a joint IEEE/IEC logo standard in the next 18 months and requested that SC 2.1 continue to work towards this goal. It was suggested that the difference between the two standards might be addressed in an annex to the standard or by listing the requirements separately within the body of the standard. The Chairman also noted that IEEE 344 would be the next IEEE SC2 Minutes 05-1 Rev1

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joint logo project.

The following Vice-Chairman had no comments.

3.2 SC-2 Member's Biographical Data Booklet

Preparation of a booklet of biographical data on SC-2 members was discussed. The Chairman noted that a proposed format for the biographical data was distributed to all SC-2 members via e-mail and comments were received from several members. Based on the comments received, a form has been developed that can be used to collect the necessary biographical data from each member. A volunteer was requested to assemble the directory and Fred Roy accepted the task. The final form will be transmitted by Fred Roy to each of the members for inclusion into the directory. All members are requested to complete this form and submit it to the prior to the next meeting [AI-04-1-1]. A digital photo can be provided, if desired by the member.

SC-2 Working Groups and Chairman

No changes were made at this meeting.

3.3 NPEC Activities

No report was provided on NPEC activities.

4.0 Preview of Revisions to IEEE 650

The chairman of WG 2.13, Dennis Dellinger, provided a draft copy of IEEE 650 for discussion. The PAR for IEEE 650 expires December 2005. A redlined copy of the standard highlighting the proposed revisions had already been distributed to the SC 2 membership in February 2005 for comment and no comments were received. There were comments in the meeting on various subjects including, but not limited to, mild environment component qualification, referencing EPRI documents within the standard and assumed activation energies.

A motion was made by the WG SC 2.13 that subcommittee SC 2 approve submission of IEEE 650 to NPEC for seeking its permission to ballot. The motion was approved unanimously by a vote of the SC 2

membership. The SC 2 Chairman requested that SC 2 members provide comments to the WG 2.13 Chairman by May 15, 2005 for incorporation into the NPEC submittal and advised member to participate in the balloting process if additional comments are warranted.

5.0 Experience in Digital I&C

Hideo Harada and Hirotsugu Suzuki, Hitachi, gave a presentation titled "Experience in Digital I&C". A copy of the presentation is included as Attachment 3.

6.0 Status Report on Special Working Group on ISO-9000

The chairman of the special working group on ISO 9000, Tom Hencey, reported on the group's recommendations related to the use of ISO standards in lieu of 10CFR50 Appendix B. The group recommended that the differences between the various quality standards be addressed by QA personnel and that SC 2 remain silent in this area.

The SC 2 chairman rejected this recommendation and initiated and action item [AI-05-1-1] for WG 2.1 to address the use of 10CFR50 Appendix B or alternative quality standards in the next revision to IEEE 323. The chairman clarified that the intent is to address the use of alternate quality standards, but not necessarily in a prescriptive manner.

7.0 Issues with Current Qualification Practices

Nissen Burstein presented this topic dealing with the differences between qualified life and service life as defined in IEEE 323. A copy of his presentation is included as Attachment 4. The SC 2 chairman requested that a revision to IEEE 323 be considered to provide clarification as necessary to address this issue.

8.0 Status of IEEE 572 Boundaries; Mild versus Harsh Environment

Bill Hadovski presented this topic and requested guidance from the committee relative to daughter standards content. The SC 2 Chairman indicated the daughter standards should be stand alone documents and provide supplemental guidance, which does not conflict with other daughter standards. A copy of his presentation is included as Attachment 8.

The working group has an approved PAR with 12-13 members in the working group. The WG chairman feels that he has a good mix of utility, manufacturing and consultants in the working group, but will accept up to three additional members if others are interested. The WG plans on meeting in June and expects to put the finishing touches on the document by October 2005.

9.0 How to Secure Nuclear Assets – Perimeter and IT Physical Security

Tony Cardo of Fiber SenSys presented this topic. A copy of this presentation is included as Attachment 5.

10.0 Status Report on the Special Working Group on Qualification of Fiber Optic Cables

Jan Pirrong reported that among the ad hoc group established to determine the need for a fiber optic cable qualification standard, there were 8 members in favor of a new standard and one dissenting member. He indicated he has sufficient interest from manufactures for development of a new standard and appealed to the SC 2 membership for greater interest in the development of this standard.

Mr. Pirrong motioned that a new standard be prepared for the qualification of fiber optic cable and the SC 2 memberships voted as follows:

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- -33 in favor
- -10 in favor for proxies
- -1 opposed
- -2 opposed for proxies

The Chairman, SC-2 had instructed the special working group to prepare a draft PAR and submit it to SC-2 for review by October 2005. [Revised AI-04-2-7]

12.0 NRC Report

The Chairman, SC-2 provided an NRC liaison report, which is included as Attachment 7.

13.0 Working Group Reports

13.1 Working Group 2.2 on Motors (IEEE Standard 334)

The Assistant Chairman of this working group, James Dean, provided the following status report:

The revised IEEE 334 standard will more closely align it with IEEE 323 and be more explicit. A draft of the revised standard will be ready for presentation to SC 2 by October 2005.

A preview to NPEC of the revised standard is planned for January 2006. [AI-04-2-3] The Chairman, SC-2 will arrange this.

A PAR is approved and is valid until 2006.

13.2 Working Group 2.3 on Motor Operated Valves (IEEE Standard 382)

The Chairman of the working group, Pat McQuillan, provided the following status of Standard 382: A request for a new PAR was prepared and submitted. IEEE did not approve the PAR and returned the request with comments. The WG Chairman indicated the comments are editorial in nature and should be resolved by the end of the month. The WG goal is to have a draft ready for review by December 2005, and ready for balloting by the September 2006 meeting [AI-04-2-4].

The WG Chairmen expects to have a draft revision prepared by the SC 2 05-2 meeting.

13.3 Working Group 2.14 on Motor Control Centers (IEEE Standard 649)

The Chairman of this working group, Robert Francis, provided the following status of this standard:

The standard was reaffirmed in September 2004. A new PAR has been approved to revise the standard to address changes in 323. The group will also investigate the possibility of addressing newer technologies which are available in newer MCC designs (e.g. communications interfaces, etc). The WG expects to present a draft revision to IEEE 334 by the 06-01 meeting.

13.4 Working Group 2.1 on Qualification (IEEE Standard 323)

The Chairman of the working group, Jim Gleason, indicated the working group is currently discussing the next revision to standard 323. The WG Chairman gave a presentation on the gaps between IEEE and ASME standards. This presentation is included as Attachment 15.

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The SC 2 Chairman requested that WG 2.1 continue to pursue the development of a joint IEEE/IEC logo standard embracing IEEE and IEC best practices and indicated that he will attempt to get IEC representation at the next WG meeting. The SC 2 Chairman requested that Working Group 2.1 have a draft dual logo standard by April 06.

14.0 Overview of GT-MHR Reactor

Mr. Arkal Shenoy of GTA presented this topic. A copy is his presentation is included as Attachment 9.

15.0 Software Qualification of Digital I&C Systems in Nuclear Power Plants

Mr. Arndt Linder of Institute for Safety Technology (ISTec) presented this topic. A copy is his presentation is included as Attachment 10.

16.0 Action Item Status
