



IEEE POWER & ENERGY SOCIETY NSW CHAPTER OUTSTANDING ENGINEER AWARD

Summary

The IEEE Power & Energy Society New South Wales Chapter Outstanding Engineer Award (OEA) is presented annually to a PES NSW Chapter member judged to have made a significant contribution to the engineering profession.

Eligibility

The recipient must be an IEEE and PES member. The recipient should be a member of the PES NSW Chapter, although the award may be made to a former member.

Previous OEA recipients are eligible for the award but only in respect of further contributions or work since their previous award.

Criteria

- Outstanding technical contributions to the power engineering profession.
- Significant contributions to the local community representing the power engineering profession.
- Outstanding contributions in the area of power engineering education.
- Outstanding professional and leadership contributions to the power engineering profession.
- Service to the Power & Energy Society and/or IEEE, particularly to the PES NSW Chapter.

Procedure and Timeline

The selection committee is appointed by the NSW Chapter Chair.

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| July | Call for nominations in July issue of <i>Circuit</i> |
| 4 weeks later | Nominations close |
| By mid-September | Nominations reviewed by selection committee and recipient selected |
| By mid-September | Chapter Chair submits OEA Request Form electronically to pes.chapters.awards@ieee.org to receive plaque |
| Late November | Presentation of PES Outstanding Engineer Award plaque to recipient at NSW Section AGM and Dinner |
