## Information

Commencing in 2019, IEEE Student Branches (SB) in NSW will receive a budget allocation based on previous year's activity. Financial incentives are outlined below as to how each student branch can accumulate funding. This approach ensures alignment with the Sections priorities and transparency as to the funding of each branch. Unused budget allocation cannot be rolled over to another year. All activities claimed must be detailed in the previous year's student branch report. A budget is required to show how funding earned will be spent. Money spent must be in the best interests of IEEE and its members. Newly formed student branches or where a branch has been inactive, up to \$1,000 may be allocated as start-up funds in the first year; a detailed plan and budget is to be submitted to the NSW Section for approval.
