## 9. Old Business

**9.1** Orange County Section to be a technical co-sponsor for the IEEE 2015 International Test Conference in Anaheim, October 4-9, 2015. At R6 OpCom John Waltz (former president of IEEE Computer Society) reported that the organizers, IEEE Philadelphia Section, are no longer using the IEEE Computer Society as a sponsor. ITC organizers plan to have the Philadelphia Section as the financial sponsor, and would like to have the Orange County Section as a technical sponsor. Director Coughlin of R6 made an inquiry to MGA to see if this arrangement is appropriate and complies with IEEE regulations.

## 10. New Business

**10.1 Adding name to listserv.ieee.org** Noah provided the procedure for adding a name to the listserv in his email of Feb 10.

- a. Navigate to <https://listserv.ieee.org/> and log in with your IEEE username/password.
- b. Under the dark blue IEEE banner in the upper left corner, select List Management -> Subscriber Management.
- c. Select the list you wish to alter from the pull down menu (I only have access to OC-EXCOM and IEEE-OC but it will show all you are manager of).
- d. Enter the email into the “Examine or Delete Subscriptions” menu. This will show you if an email account already has a subscription (it is possible to have a subscription and be set to NOT get emails).
- e. If the user has a subscription, make sure they are set to receive email and their posting privileges are set properly (use a good working account for reference if needed).
- f. If the user has no subscription, create it by using the “Add New Subscriber” menu.

**10.2 Section Facilitation of joint chapter meeting.** Chapter chairs and/or chapter program chairs are encouraged to announce technical meetings in advance to other chapter chairs and invite other chapters that may be technical aligned with the meeting subject to co-sponsor the events. This will allow less active chapters to meet minimum meeting requirements to qualify for chapter rebates. Chapters are also encouraged to have joint meetings with other technical societies outside IEEE to increase participation and share costs of programs.
