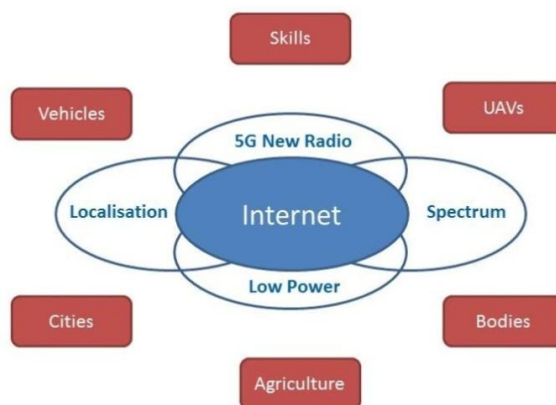

349 full papers have been included in the final program; **415 attendees** have subscribed to PIMRC 2018 already. The Call for Recent Results Papers attracted 70 more scientific contributions whose Authors will register in the coming week. **We expect to meet in Bologna more than 500 scientists**, from industry, research centres and academia, representing Countries of Europe, Asia, Americas and Africa.

The 2018 edition is dedicated to the **theme: “Towards a Connected World of People and Things”**. **We will discuss the process of migration from a global context dominated by human-oriented devices, towards an ecosystem where the majority of objects connected wirelessly to the Internet will be unmanned.**
