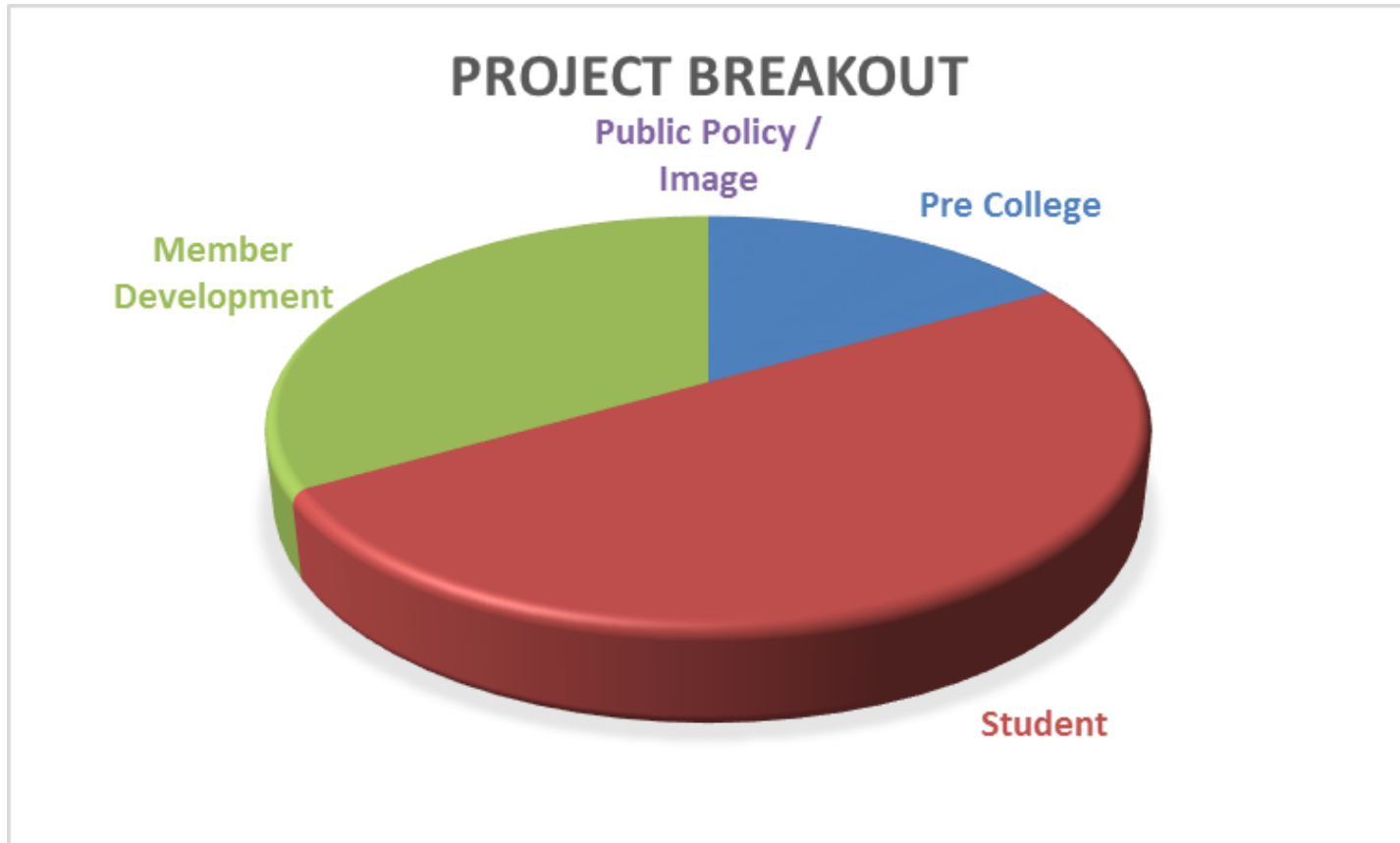
Dissemination of PACE News

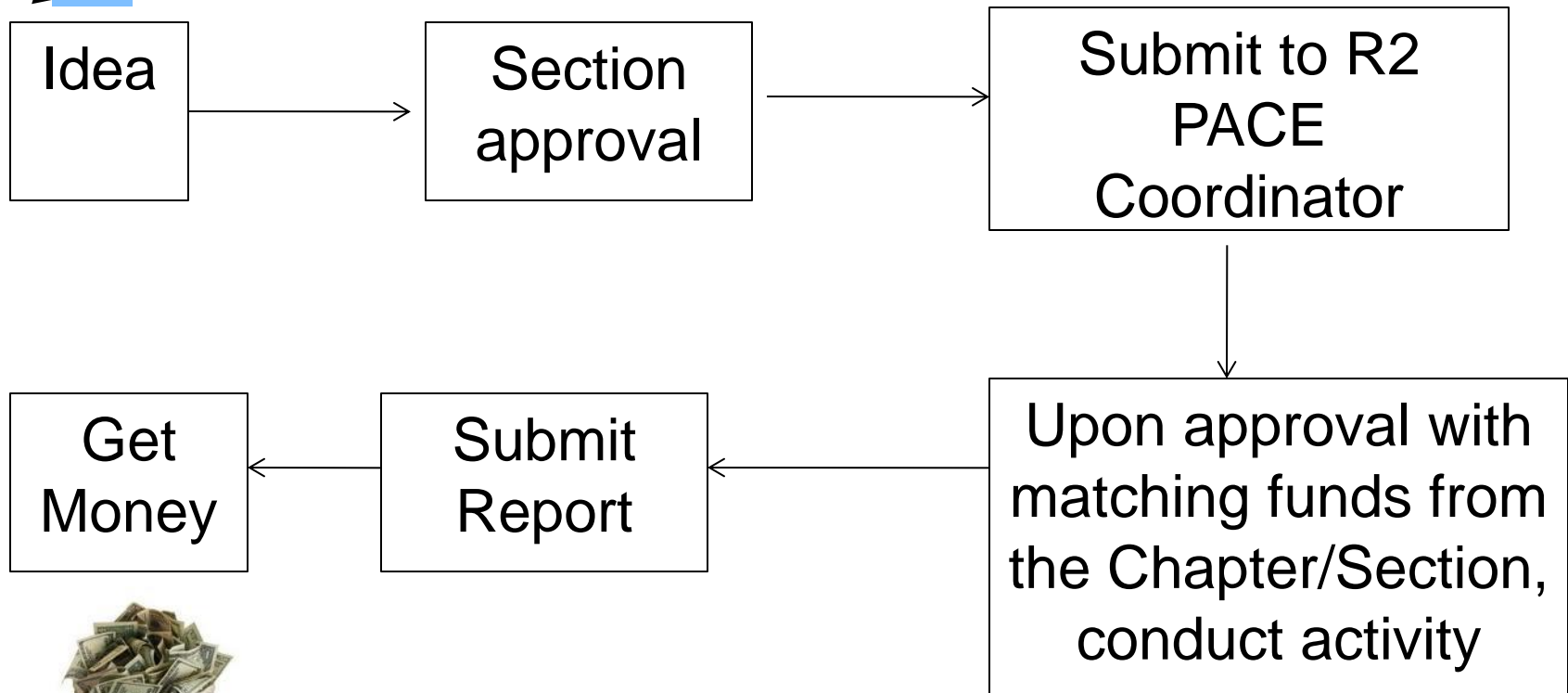

PACE Guidelines for 2013

- ❑ PACE projects submitted will be reviewed on a first-come first-served basis.
- ❑ All Section PACE Projects submitted to the Region 2 PACE Coordinator will be judged on their applicability in benefiting members on a professional level and/or students on a career enhancement basis
- ❑ Sections are encouraged to engage in PACE projects which:
 - ❑ Are no or low cost projects
 - ❑ Utilize secondary sources of funding to support the maximum amount of the total projected cost of the project as possible

2013 IEEE-USA ANNUAL CONFERENCE

- The 2013 IEEE-USA Annual Conference (formerly the Annual PACE Conference) is going to be held in Portland Oregon August 1st to Sunday August 4th.
- I will be distributing information about the annual meeting to the Section Chairs and Section Pace Coordinators over the next several months as the information becomes available.
- Attendees
 - \$500 for first-time attendees
 - \$250 for second-time attendees

MEMBER PROFESSIONAL ENGAGEMENT (MPE) PROGRAM

- The IEEE-USA PACE MPE program which began in 2012 is being offered again to Sections in 2013. Sections successfully applying receive \$200. The basic guidelines of this program remain unchanged in 2013:
 - 3 or more PACE events planned and implemented in 2013
 - Combined attendance at all 3 or more events totals at least 100 people
 - Events must be reported using vTools and classified as a “Professional” activity
 - **Note: Only the first 100 Sections to successfully satisfy all requirements will be awarded \$200.**
- I encourage all Sections to participate in the MPE program. Please contact me if you have any questions regarding this program.
