Milestone: DIALOG Online Search System, 1966

This milestone will be dedicated at the Lockheed facility in Palo Alto, CA sometime during the month of May. The date should be finalized soon. This search tool is used to this day, and it is known as ProQuest Dialog. Many do not realize it, but there is a huge cache of scientific and medical data which is only available via this tool as it has been costly to create and is thus not given away for free on the Internet. This tool predated internet search tools by well over 2 decades, and NASA data was the first cache of data to be made accessible via dial-up lines back in 1966. The European Space Agency soon joined in, and data was accessed via multiple sites in Europe and North America via a satellite connection in the 1970s. I worked with the originator of this tool to get this Milestone approved in late 2018.



Milestone: Apollo 11 Lunar Laser Ranging Experiment, 1969

▶ This milestone will be dedicated on Aug. 1 atop Mt. Hamilton at Lick Observatory, which overlooks Silicon Valley. A larger event in the Mtn View, CA area will take place around that same date, and I am working with NASA on this effort. I hope to have details soon. With the worldwide excitement about the July 20 50th anniversary of Apollo 11 just beginning to wane, the excitement should pick back up with the 50th anniversary of the first Earth-to-Moon distance measurement with centimeter accuracy - particularly because of the interesting backstories that include aspects of the Cold War as well as of the recent popular film Hidden Figures.
