IEEE Canada Awards and Contests

George Armitage Outstanding Student Branch Award

To recognize extraordinary Student Branch achievements through

- Effective interaction of the Branch with the local Section or Region
- Seminars, conferences, S-PACs, S-PAVes;
- Community involvement

IEEE Regional Exemplary Student Branch Award

To encourage, through public recognition, exemplary Student Branch operation.

- No limit to the number of awards given.
- Nomination must be by an Officer of the Branch.



IEEE Canada Awards and Contests

Larry K. Wilson Regional Student Activities Award

- To recognize the student most responsible for an extraordinary accomplishment associated with student activities.
- Commemorative plaque and 3 years free membership in the IEEE.

Website Competition

- Regional competition prizes of \$500, \$350, \$150
- Global competitions prizes of \$1000, \$750, \$500, \$250



IEEE Canada Awards and Contests

IEEE Canada Student Paper Competition

For each Council in Canada (Western, Central and Eastern), there are three awards:

IEEE Life Member Award for the best overall paper – the prize is \$500 per team of students (one or more)

Hackbusch Award

for the runner-up paper by a team of University students (one or more) – the prize is \$250 per team

Palin Award

for the runner-up paper by a team of College students (one or more) – the prize is \$250 per team

- A global challenge in which teams of IEEE student members compete in a 24-hour time span against each other to solve a set of programming problems.
