Organizational Structure





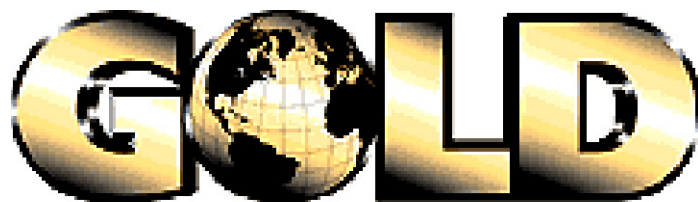
IEEE Canada



- Operates 20 Sections in 3 areas (Western, Central, and Eastern Canada), and 50+ student branches in universities and colleges across Canada

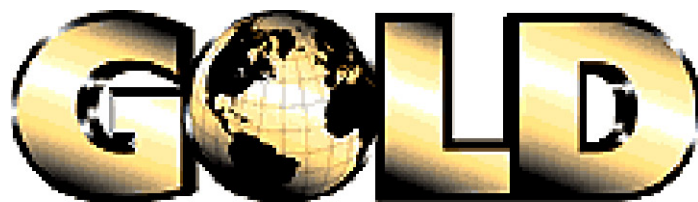

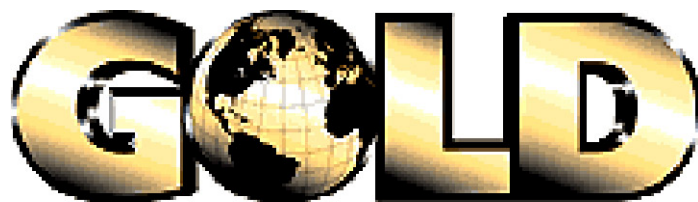
- What is IEEE GOLD?
