Project STEAM Sessions I and III (15 different workshops - some repeated)

Business presenters will be partnered with a team of teachers well in advance of the conference. Together they will plan a project or lesson focused on the content/skills/ etc. of both the business and teachers. We will seek out business partners and teachers from all areas including math, science, tech, computer science, engineering, arts, business, and ELA. We will need help in identifying these folks. Each session we hope to have 11 selections and a 12th one designed for guidance counselors, business professionals and administrators. Each session will be one hour, and some presenters may repeat their sessions. We are also hoping the businesses will provide resources for the participants that will enable them to use the project/lesson right away in classrooms. If the resources are too expensive we can offer one "kit" and it can be raffled at the end of the workshop. The presenters will be given a template develop the project or unit. Teacher teams will be provided with a \$500.00 stipend to support their planning time.







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Each workshop session will include:

- Overview of the business and the employment opportunities
- · Discussions of the skills and training required
- Education/training required by the business for employment opportunities.
- Project template and discussion.
- Attendees will receive a thumb drive with the plan of the lessons or project that can be used right away in classrooms.
