Workshop announcement

The 2019 Swedish Communication Technologies Workshop (Swe-CTW'2019) will be held at Lund University on June 10th - June 12th, 2019. Swe-CTW'2019 will bring together researchers and research students in the general area of communication technologies and related areas.

The workshop provides an opportunity for researchers and research students to gather in a largely informal setting to share ideas, make contacts, and foster new collaborative links for the future. The workshop will feature tutorials, poster presentations of submitted abstracts, and invited talks by the top nominated papers for the IEEE VT/COM/IT Sweden Best Student Paper Awards.

Poster abstract submission

Submitted abstracts will be reviewed for relevance and technical quality in line with the scope and quality of previously held Swe-CTW. The abstracts will not appear in any proceedings - only in the Book of Abstracts. Submitted abstracts can be from published, submitted, or previously unpublished material in the general areas of communication technologies and related areas. The abstract should be of a maximum of 300 words and submitted together with title, list of authors, and potential reference to where it has been published/submitted to IEEE.SweCTW@gmail.com at the latest May 6, 2019. After this date, poster slots will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis, subject to limitations on available space. A poster presentation slot will be allocated to all accepted abstracts.
