1. Approval of the agenda (IJ/SH) Carried.
2. Approval of the minutes of the May meeting (SH/EH) Carried.
3. Chair Report
  - a. DS will arrange a training session for new IEEE volunteer tools in September (after the Section meeting)
    - Including direct deposit for events
  - b. Lakehead has a new student chapter councilor, getting active again
    - We are looking for ways to get them involved
  - c. DS identified 10+ people in the Section that are eligible for senior membership
    - Either hold a SM event or contact individually
      - i. Individually would most likely work better
    - Mainly for recognition, the change to the Section rebate is marginal
    - Conference fees may be less for SM
    - EH could provide references for candidates
4. Vice-Chair Report
  - a. Held a seminar (Dr. Zhao from McMaster), also here for a Ph.D. examination
    - Can IEEE pay for accommodation expenses for 1 night?
      - i. FGS only supplied \$250, ECE used to cover expenses
      - ii. SH: This may set a precedent, as professors visiting for defenses typically give talks
      - iii. IJ: Not a bad 'investment', but we should know of the talks in advance to provide ample time for advertising
      - iv. IJ will draft a set of rules for dealing with these requests in the future (capped amount, limit per Chapter, etc.), SH will assist
      - v. Motion: To cover \$160 for Dr. Zhao's expenses (EH/CH) passed

  - a. We did not receive a bonus on the rebate because EMBS only reported one event

      - vi. Motion: To approve up to \$500 for WIE as startup funds (NA/IJ) passed
