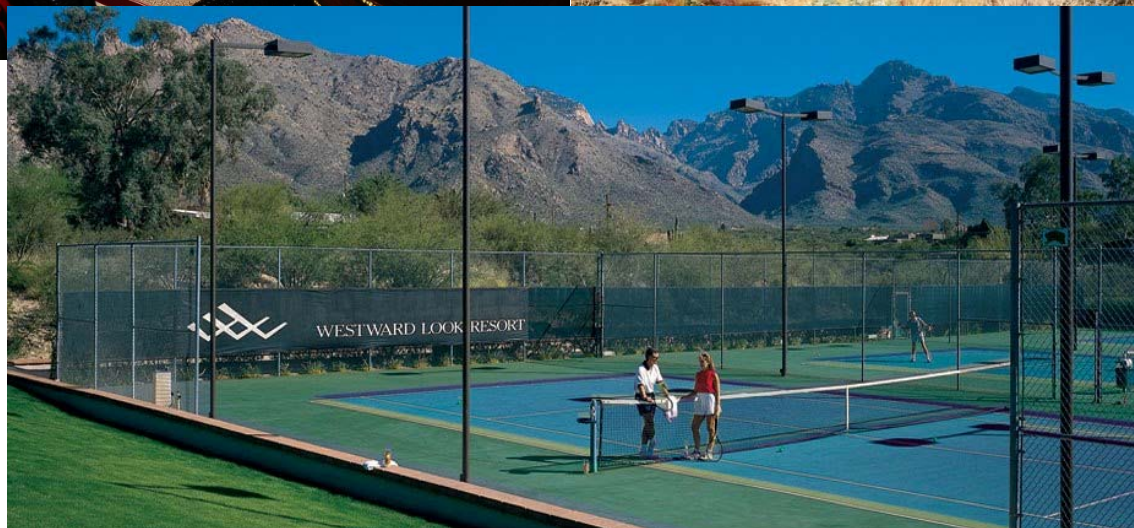
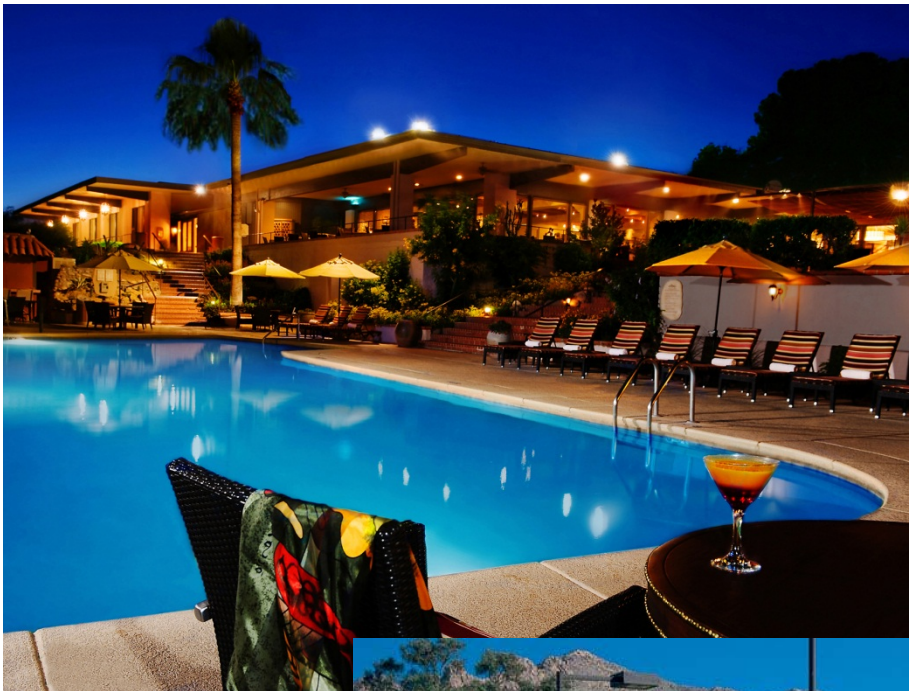

TC Voting Member

- Individual who has:
 1. “attended” (physically, by teleconference, or virtual meetings) two or more of the prior five regularly scheduled meetings;
 2. Or contributed substantially to the TC activities.
- TC Secretary shall maintain attendance list for each meeting.
- TC voting members - IEEE Communications Society Member or Affiliate member

TC elections

- May be held electronically (e.g., email).
- Approval by simple majority.
- Necessary to register to vote and two-thirds of those registered must vote.
- Officer of the TC conducts the election and reports election results to the TC membership, VP – TA, Secretary of TAC, and ComSoc headquarters in NYC

Technical Committee Business

Conferences
