Operation of TPOLICE ENERGY CONVERSION CONGRESS & EXPO

- TPC Chairs (2): Select and form TPC; facilitate and monitor the review process; finalize conference programs; ONLY make decision on "anomaly" papers (<1% and in consultation with at least 2 vice chairs)
- TPC Vice Chairs (~10+10): Nominate and form subcommittees (Topic Chairs or TPC members); monitor the review process (frequent email and conference call communication); attend the TPC meeting in April; review and decide on Topic Chairs' recommendations; assist in finalizing conference programs
- TPC Topic Chairs (~70): Find and invite reviewers in the topic area; assign papers to reviewers and send reminders; review reviewers' input and make recommendations to Vice Chairs



- Nominate TPC Vice Chairs (~20)
- Respond to invitations from TPC Chairs to serve as Topic Chairs (TPC members)
- Submit tutorial and/or special session proposals
- Review papers
- Solicit sponsors and exhibitors (at least your own organization)
- Voice your concerns and suggestions
